1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Golu Kumar @ Priyanshu Kumar, S/o Laxman Sahni.

2. The Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under section 482 of the BNSS apprehending his arrest in Mushahari P.S.Case No.28/2026, registered u/s 329(4), 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of BNS.

3. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.

4. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in concocted case. It has further submitted that nothing has happened as in the manner alleged. Both parties are Pattidar and the instant case has been filed by exaggerating the facts due to some previous land dispute. No one sustained any type of injury.

5. Prosecution case, in brief is that in the night of 01.01.2026, all the accused, whose names are mentioned in the FIR alongwith 10 unknown forcibly entered into house of informant Niraj Kumar Sahni and started abusing his mother and Golu Kumar and Suraj Kumar assaulted his mother with bamboo. It is further alleged that accused persons also took away cash and ornaments from his house and damaged the household articles.

6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.

7. On perusal of record including the F.I.R., it appears that there is common allegation against the petitioner that he alongwith one co-accused person had assaulted on the body informant's mother by a bamboo and in the result there was pain in the body of informant's mother. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner regarding assault on any vital part of body. Rest of the allegations are vague and omnibus. As per para no.3 of anticipatory bail application, the petitioner has got no criminal history.

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8. Considering the above facts & circumstances and the nature of allegation against the petitioner, the prayer of anticipatory bail is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the petitioner namely, **Golu Kumar @ Priyanshu Kumar, S/o Laxman Sahni** be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of learned court concerned and subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.
