This application has been filed, on behalf of the accused petitioners in custody, namely, (1) Chandan Kumar and (2) Chotu Kumar, for grant of regular bail, in connection with Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 264/2026, registered u/s 309(4) of the B.N.S., pending in the Ld. Court of C.J.M., Muzaffarpur.

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioners and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioners has submitted that previously no anticipatory or regular bail petitions, of any nature had been filed by the the accused petitioners, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioners have got criminal history of three cases. That the petitioners are quite innocent, have committed no any offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. That no any specific allegations as levelled against the petitioners and no any incriminating articles have been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. That the petitioners are not named in the FIR and their names have been surfaced in this case, on the basis of confessional statement of other co-accused persons and self confession. That the petitioners are in judicial custody, in this case, since 13.03.2026. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners side, prays for their release on bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the original record, including the FIR and case diary, from paras no. 01 to 119. From perusal of the record, it transpires that petitioners are not named in the FIR and they have been implicated in this case, on the basis of confessional statements, recorded by the police. Allegation relates to theft/extortion of gas cylinders etc. There is no recovery from these petitioners. The present petitioners were not apprehended on the spot. Some other co-accused persons have already been granted regular bail, by the court and case for bail of the petitioners, stands on similar footing. The petitioners are in

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, including period of jail custody, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. Accordingly, bail application of the accused petitioners, namely, **(1) Chandan Kumar and (2) Chotu Kumar**, stands **allowed** and they are directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, each, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
