

**In the Court Of 1<sup>st</sup> Additional Sessions Judge, Muzaffarpur****A.B.P No.2014/2026****Bharat Bhushan @ Sonu..... Petitioner.****Vs.****State of Bihar.....O.P.****O R D E R****26.05.2026**

This application has been filed, for grant of anticipatory bail, on behalf of the accused petitioner, namely, Bharat Bhushan @ Sonu, in connection with Ahiyapur P.S. Case no. 1086/2015, registered U/Ss 143, 144, 145, 341, 323, 186, 332, 333, 353, 307, 379, 427, 504 of the IPC, pending in the Ld. Court of C.J.M., Muzaffarpur.

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner has submitted that previously no anticipatory or regular bail petitions of any nature had been filed by the accused petitioner, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got no criminal history. That the petitioner is quite innocent, has not committed any offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. That entire prosecution story is completely false and fabricated. That the petitioner has been dragged into this litigation solely on the basis of suspicion and local enmity stemming from village politics. It has further been submitted that the petitioner has got genuine apprehension of his arrest in this case. Ld. counsel for the petitioner side, prays for his release on anticipatory bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the record, including the F.I.R and case diary, from paras no. 01 to 125. From perusal of the record, it transpires that allegations against this petitioner are general, vague and omnibus in nature. FIR in this case has been lodged against 19 named accused persons. No any specific allegation has been levelled against this petitioner and no any specific overt act has been attributed to him. The petitioner has got no criminal history, as per para no. 03 of the anticipatory bail application.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, including the nature of allegations, against the accused petitioner, the prayer for anticipatory bail, in respect of him, is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event

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of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, the accused petitioner, namely, **Bharat Bhushan @ Sonu**, is directed to be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousands) with two sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below and subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
