ORDER

18.05.2026. Instant application for grant of regular bail has been filed on behalf of above named accused/petitioner who has been in custody since 25.04.2026 in connection with Town P.S. Case No. 268/2026, registered u/Ss 126(2), 115(2), 117(1), 109, 351(2), 351(3), 352, 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S.

Heard Mr. Nikhil Verma, learned advocate for the accused/petitioner and Ms. Sangita Sahi, learned Addl. P.P. for the State as well as Mr. Ram Kumar, learned advocate for the informant.

Allegation against the accused/petitioner, in brief, is that he with an intention to kill struck informant with iron rod on 24.04.2026.

Learned Advocate for the accused/petitioner has submitted that accused/petitioner is quite innocent. Besides this case, he is also accused in complaint case no. 2570/2025 and Town P.S. Case No. 715/2023. Ld. Advocate has also submitted that no bail petition has been filed earlier on his behalf before either this court or the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. Informant is own brother of the accused/petitioner and there is dispute over shop and accused/petitioner has also lodged Town P.S. Case No. 821/2023 against informant of this case. Moreover, both parties have compromised and informant is present in the court to support the factum of compromise. Furthermore, accused/petitioner has been in custody since 25.04.2026. So, he may be granted bail.

On the other hand, learned Addl. P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail. However, learned Addl. P.P. for the State as well as learned advocate for the informant concedes that parties have entered into compromise.

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Contd..... After hearing both sides, this court perused certified copy of the F.I.R., copy of
18.05.2026 case diary, compromise petition and then finds that admittedly informant and accused/petitioner are own brothers and they have now entered into compromise. Although informant has suffered head injuries, they are simple in nature. Furthermore, accused/petitioner has been in custody since 25.04.2026.

So, considering the nature of allegation against the accused/petitioner in the F.I.R., his period of custody and other facts discussed above, this court is inclined to grant the accused/petitioner bail.

Accordingly, he is directed to be released on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned court.

Accordingly, his regular bail petition is hereby **allowed**.
