1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Srivan Kumar @ Golu Kumar, S/o- Deepak Mishra.
2. The Petitioner is seeking regular bail under section 483 of the BNSS, in Kudhani P.S. Case No. 59 of 2026, registered under section 317(4), 317(5), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 111 BNS & 25(1-B)a, 26, 35 of Arms Act.
3. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 16.04.2026.
4. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
5. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. The entire prosecution story is totally false and concocted. Nothing incriminating material has been recovered from possession of the petitioner.
6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.
7. The case of informant, Punit Kumar (S.H.O., Kudhani P.S.) in brief is that on 15.04.2026, around 16:15 hrs., while he was on patrolling duty, he received secret information that three suspected criminals, riding on two motorcycles, had assembled near Aam Bagicha, Railway Gumti No. 17 with intention of committing a criminal act. To verify the same, the informant reached there alongwith police party. On seeing the police vehicle, the suspects attempted to flee, but they were apprehended and disclosed their names as Srivan Kumar @ Golu Kumar (petitioner herein), Ayush Kumar and Pritam Raj. On being search, a country made pistol with one live cartridge alongwith two smartphones were recovered from possession of Srivan Kumar, from possession of Ayush Kumar, one live

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cartridge and one smartphone were recovered whereas from possession of accused Pritam Raj, one live cartridge was recovered. Accordingly, seizure list was prepared and F.I.R. was registered.

8. On perusal of record including the F.I.R., it appears that the present petitioner has been alleged to be in possession of one country made pistol with one cartridge and two smartphones, as per the seizure list. Ownership of the recovered smartphone is not known but Id. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the phone belonged to the petitioner itself. Informant of this case is a police official and seizure list witness is also police personnel. Further, the petitioner is in judicial custody since 16.04.2026. Other co-accused person has already been granted regular bail by this court.
9. Taking into account the nature of allegation against the petitioner and also the fact that he is first time offender and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence or would influence the investigation in any manner, let the petitioner namely Srivan Kumar @ Golu Kumar, S/o- Deepak Mishra be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned, subject to following conditions:-
 - The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigating agency as well as in the trial, as and when required.
 - The petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
 - The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
 - The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
