- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioners/accused 1. Munna Thakur, S/o Prahalad Thakur and 2. Chandan Kumar Thakur, S/o Late Arun Thakur.
- (2) The petitioners are seeking regular bail under section 439 of the Cr.P.C., in Complaint Case No. 1393 of 2014, registered under section 302/34 of the IPC.
- (3) The petitioners are in judicial custody since 09.04.2026.
- (4) Ld. counsel for the petitioners submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (5) Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that petitioners are innocent and have not committed offence as alleged in the F.I.R. against them. The names of these petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case merely on the basis of suspicion. The occurrence took place on 30.09.2008 but the complaint was filed on 24.10.2008 after lapse of 24 days and F.I.R. was lodged on 07.04.2009 i.e. after 7 months. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that during investigation, the police has found that the deceased has committed suicide which is mentioned in the case diary.
- (6) The case of the complainant is that his sister was married to Ram Pravesh Thakur who works at a saloon in Muzaffarpur. He lives the house at 07:00 AM and returns at 09:30 PM. It is alleged that on 30.09.2008, the accused entered the house of deceased had a confrontation with her and thereafter killed her by strangulation.
- (7) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present bail petition.
- (8) Perused the TCR including the case diary and P.M. report. The death is opined to have caused by asphyxia, as a result of which of hanging. On perusal of case diary including para no. 7, 8 and 9, it is reflected that the victim committed suicide by

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hanging herself and the door was found locked from inside which was opened by the neighbours. Apart from that nothing has been mentioned by the witnesses during the investigation. The police also submitted the final form stating it to be a mistake of fact and finding the case not true u/s 302 IPC r/w Section 34 of the IPC.

- (9) Accordingly, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances wherein no case prima facie is alleged to have been made out against the petitioners u/s 302 IPC r/w Section 34 of the IPC. Let the above named petitioners be released on bail on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned subject to following conditions:-

- The petitioners shall co-operate in the trial, as and when required.
- The petitioners shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
