- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Aakash Kumar, S/o Parshuram Yadav.
- (2) The petitioner is seeking regular bail under section 483 of the BNSS, in Sadar PS Case No.434 of 2026 registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 3(5) of the BNS.
- (3) The petitioner is in judicial custody since 26.04.2026.
- (4) Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (5) The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this false and concocted case. Petitioner was not present at the P.O. The ingredients of section 109 of the BNS is not made out against him. Petitioner's father had also lodged Sadar P.S. Case No. 442/2026 against the informant and others.
- (6) The case of informant Appu Thakur is that on 24.04.2026, around 07:30 PM, he had gone near Mahesh Prasad Singh Science College at his friend's function, while he was returning home, around 07:45 PM, he was surrounded by 7 to 8 unknown persons, was assaulted by them and his gold chain and mobile were snatched.
- (7) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.
- (8) Looking at the nature of allegations against the petitioner and the fact that there is case and counter case and the petitioner was badly assaulted in the counter case and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, let the petitioner, namely Aakash Kumar, S/o Parshuram Yadav be released on bail on

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furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned court subject to the following conditions:-

- The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigation agency as well as in trial, as and when required.
- The petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
