

In the Court Of 1st Additional Sessions Judge, Muzaffarpur**A.B.P No. 2010/2026****Md. Rahmat Ali @ Munna.....Petitioner.****Vs.****State of Bihar.....O.P.****O R D E R****18.05.2026**

This application has been filed, for grant of anticipatory bail, on behalf of the accused petitioner, namely, Md. Rahmat Ali @ Munna, in connection with Kathaiya P.S. Case no. 95/2025, registered U/Ss 191(2), 191(3), 190, 329(3), 329(4), 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 74, 75, 352, 351(2), 351(3) of the B.N.S., pending in the Ld. Court of S.D.J.M. Muzaffarpur (West).

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner has submitted that previously no anticipatory or regular bail petitions of any nature had been filed by the accused petitioner, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got no criminal history. That the petitioner is quite innocent, has not committed any offence and has falsely been implicated in this case, due to dirty village politics and enmity. That entire allegations, as levelled against the petitioner, are false and fabricated and there is no specific allegation against him. That there is case and counter case between both the parties. That some other co-accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail by the court. It has further been submitted that the petitioner has got genuine apprehension of his arrest in this case. Ld. counsel for the petitioner side, prays for his release on anticipatory bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the record, including the F.I.R. From perusal of the record, it transpires that allegations against this petitioner are general, vague and omnibus in nature. FIR in this case has been lodged against 29 named and about 150 unknown persons. No any specific allegation has been levelled against this petitioner and no any specific overt act has been attributed to him. Some other co-accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail by the the court. The petitioner has got no criminal history, as per para no. 03 of the anticipatory bail application.

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Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, including the nature of allegations, against the accused petitioner, the prayer for anticipatory bail, in respect of him, is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, the accused petitioner, namely, **Md. Rahmat Ali @ Munna**, is directed to be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousands) with two sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below and subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 482(2) of the B.N.S.S. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
