O R D E R

This application has been filed, on behalf of the accused petitioner in custody, namely, Ravikant Thakur @ Ravi Kumar, for grant of regular bail, in connection with Sahebganj P.S. Case No. 301/2026, registered U/Ss 317(5), 317(2), 318(4), 303(2), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S., pending in the Ld. court of A.C.J.M. 2nd, Muzaffarpur (West).

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner has submitted that previously no anticipatory or regular bail petitions, of any nature had been filed by the the accused petitioner, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got criminal history of three cases. That the petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case by the police at the instance of his enemies. That entire allegations as levelled against the petitioner are false and fabricated. That nothing incriminating has been recovered from possession of the petitioner. That the alleged seized motorcycle bearing registration no. BR-06DY-7881 is registered in the name of wife of the petitioner Seema Kumari and the same is not stolen one. That the ATM card in the name of the Seema Kumari, which is mentioned in the seizure is of petitioner's wife and the petitioner has no concern with other ATM cards alleged to have been recovered in this case. That all the alleged seized incriminating articles are not marked, wrapped, pocketed and sealed at the place of occurrence. That the petitioner is in judicial custody, in this case, since 14.04.2026. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner side, prays for his release on bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the record, including the FIR. Updated case diary has not been submitted by Ld. APP for the State. From perusal of the record, it transpires that

the petitioner has been alleged to be in possession of ATM Cards and motorcycle, which according to the prosecution, is stolen one. As per search and seizure memo, six ATM cards, one motorcycle and one mobile phone have been recovered from possession of the petitioner. The petitioner side has produced document, showing that seized the said motorcycle is registered in the name of the petitioner's wife. Apart from the allegation of being in possession of a stolen ATM Cards, there is no other allegation against the petitioner. The petitioner side has submitted that the recovered materials have been implanted by the police to frame the petitioner. The petitioner is in judicial custody in this case, since 14.04.2026.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, including period of jail custody, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, bail application of the accused petitioner, namely, **Ravikant Thakur @ Ravi Kumar**, stands **allowed** and he is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
