1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused namely, 1. Md. Manjur @ Md. Manjur Alam, S/o-late Md. Abdul @ Abdul Sakur.
2. The Petitioner is seeking regular bail under section 483 of the BNSS in connection with Panapur Kariyat P.S. Case No. 68/2026, registered under section 317(2) (5) of the BNS.
3. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 08.05.2026.
4. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
5. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he is innocent and has not committed any offence. Petitioners has got no criminal antecedent. The entire prosecution story is false, concocted and fabricated.
6. The case of the informant is that in the night of 2nd May, 2026, a large quantity of iron was stolen from the furnace at Panapur. Later, he came to know that the Police has recovered 30% of the stolen items from the scrap dealer Manjur Alam and he could not say as to who gave him those items.
7. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present regular bail petition.
8. Taking into account the nature of allegation against the petitioner and the fact that he is first time offender and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence or would influence the investigation in any manner, let the petitioner namely 1. Md. Manjur @ Md. Manjur Alam, S/o-late Md. Abdul @ Abdul Sakur be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two

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sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned, subject to following conditions:-

- The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigating agency as well as in the trial, as and when required.
- The petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
