

B.P. No. 788/2026**Anuvarat Ravi @ Vikku..... Petitioner.****Vs.****State of Bihar.....O.P.****O R D E R****03.06.2026**

This application has been filed, on behalf of the accused petitioner in custody, namely, Anuvarat Ravi @ Vikku, for grant of regular bail, in connection with Maniyari P.S. Case No. 276/2023, registered U/Ss 384, 387, 414, 34 of the IPC and 27 of the Arms Act, pending in the Ld. court of A.C.J.M. 8th, Muzaffarpur (West).

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner, has submitted that previously no anticipatory or regular bail petitions, of any nature had been filed by the the accused petitioner, either in his court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got criminal history of nine cases and he is on bail in all those cases. That the petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case, due to dirty village politics. That the petitioner was not apprehended on the spot and his name has surfaced in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused. That nothing has been recovered from possession of the petitioner. That the petitioner is in judicial custody, in this case, since 13.02.2026. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner side, prays for his release on bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the original record, including the FIR and case diary, from paras no. 01 to 170. From perusal of the record, it transpires that petitioner was not apprehended on the spot and his name has surfaced in this case on the basis of purported statement of one co-accused. Further, there is no recovery of any incriminating material, from possession of this petitioner. Informant of this case is police official. Allegation of firing is also not against this petitioner. It is also not clear who were subjected to firing. There is no mention of any injury to any person, as well. The petitioner is in judicial custody, in this case, since 13.02.2026.

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Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, including period of jail custody, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, bail application of the accused petitioner, namely, **Anuvarat Ravi @ Vikku**, stands **allowed** and he is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
