This application has been filed, on behalf of the accused petitioner in custody, namely, Laldeo Sahni, for grant of regular bail, in connection with Motipur P.S. Case No. 433/2019, registered U/Ss 341, 324, 307, 379, 504, 34 of the IPC, pending in the Ld. Court of Sri Abhishek Kumar, J.M.F.C., Court No. 08, Muzaffarpur (West).

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner has submitted that earlier, petitioner had filed a regular bail petition before the Ld. Trial court, the same was rejected by the court no. 08 of Ld. J.M.F.C, Muzaffarpur (West) and except that petition, no other anticipatory or regular bail petitions, of any nature had been filed by the the accused petitioner, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got criminal history of four cases. That the petitioner is quite innocent, has not committed any offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. That the prosecution case is completely false, concocted and the same does not appeal to normal reasoning. That the petitioner is not named in the FIR and his name has surfaced in this case, during investigation and in supervision report. That the petitioner is in judicial custody, in this case, since 22.04.2026. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner side, prays for his release on bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the record, including the FIR and case diary, from paras no. 01 to 162. From perusal of the record, it transpires that petitioner is not named in the FIR and his name has surfaced in this case, on the basis of statements of witnesses in CD paras no. 144 & 145, during investigation. The petitioner was not apprehended on the spot and no offence material has been recovered from his conscious possession. Further, allegations against the petitioner are vague and omnibus in nature and common with several other co-accused persons. No specific overt act has been attributed to this petitioner. Some co-accused

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persons have been granted anticipatory bail, earlier in this case and case for bail of the petitioner stands on better footing. The petitioner is in judicial custody, in this case, since 22.04.2026.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, including period of jail custody, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, bail application of the accused petitioner, namely, **Laldeo Sahni**, stands **allowed** and he is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
