This application has been filed, on behalf of the accused petitioner in custody, namely, Lakshman Rai, for grant of regular bail, in connection with Sakra P.S. Case No. 199/2024, registered U/Ss 147, 148, 324, 307, 34 of the IPC, pending in the Court No. 01 of Ld. J.M.F.C., Muzaffarpur (East).

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner, Ld. Counsel for the informant and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner has submitted that earlier petitioner had filed anticipatory bail petition vide A.B.P. No. 1685/2024, before the court, which was rejected by the court and thereafter, he had filed Cr. Misc. No. 67254/2024, before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna, which was dismissed as withdrawn and except these petitions, no other anticipatory or regular bail petitions of any nature had been filed by the accused petitioner, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got criminal history of one case. That the petitioner is quite innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. That there is case and counter case between both the parties. That the petitioner is an old man and is suffering from many diseases. That the petitioner is in judicial custody in this case, since 22.05.2026. The petitioner side, prays for his release on bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state and Ld. Counsel for the informant, opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the original record, including the F.I.R. and case diary, from paras no. 01 to 85. From perusal of the record, it transpires that there is direct and specific allegation against the petitioner and main allegation against the petitioner is that he had assaulted on the head of the informant's son, by 'Khanti', due to which the informant's son had sustained grievous injuries in the parietal region. Injury report corroborates the allegation of prosecution, against

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this petitioner. Witnesses in paras no. 02, 05, 06, 07 & 08 of the case diary, have also supported the allegations of prosecution, against this petitioner. The petitioner appears to be the prime accused of the case and case for bail of this petitioner does not stand on similar footing, vis-a-vis the other co-accused persons.

Considering these facts and circumstances of the case, including nature and gravity of allegation, against the petitioner, I am not inclined to enlarge him on bail. Accordingly, bail application of the accused petitioner, namely, **Lakshman Rai**, stands **rejected**.
