- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Nikhil Kumar, S/o- Manohar Singh.
- (2) The Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS apprehending his arrest in Panapur Kariyat P.S. Case No. 08/2026 registered under sections 191(2), 191(3), 221, 223, 224, 285, 115(2), 126(2), 118(1), 121(1), 132, 351(2), (3), 352 BNS.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (4) Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. The entire prosecution story is false and fabricated.
- (5) The case of prosecution in brief is that an information was received by informant that a mob of intermediate's students led by Aman Kumar alongwith others have blocked the road due to non-receipt of admit cards. To verify the same, the informant reached there and tried to pacify them but they started raising slogans and setting fire on the road by the instigation of private coaching operators.
- (6) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.
- (7) On perusal of the FIR, it is reflected that no specific overt act is attributed to the petitioner herein and other similarly placed co-accused person has already been granted anticipatory bail vide ABP No. 1526/2026 by this court.
- (8) Taking into account the nature of allegation and the fact that petitioner is first time offender and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on

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bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the above named petitioner Nikhil Kumar, S/o- Manohar Singh be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned subject to following conditions:

- The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigating agency as well as in the trial, as and when required.
- The petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
