- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Ajay Kumar, S/o Yogendar Pd. Yadav.
- (2) The Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS apprehending his arrest in Minapur P.S. Case No. 490/2025, registered under section 303(2) of the BNS.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (4) Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedents. All the allegations are false and concocted and the section 303(2) BNS does not attract against him.
- (5) The case of the informant, Kundan Kumar is that Ajay Kumar works in his ice cream factory and he had given his motorcycle for doing work. After working for sometime, he stopped coming and when he asked to return the motorcycle, he started evading on one pretext or other.
- (6) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.
- (7) Looking at the nature of allegation against the petitioner and the fact that he is a first time offender and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the petitioner namely, Ajay Kumar, S/o Yogendar Pd. Yadav be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned subject to following conditions:

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- The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigating agency as well as in the trial, as and when required.
- The petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
