ORDER

09.06.2026 The present bail petition filed on behalf of petitioner, who is in custody in connection with Deoria PS Case No. 101/2025 since 23.05.2026.

Heard, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and learned P.P. appearing on behalf of the State.

The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence and has got one criminal antecedent i.e., Deoria P.S. Case No. 100/2025 on which he is on bail. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are general and omnibus in nature and no specific overt act has been attributed against the petitioner. Earlier other co-accused persons have granted the benefit of regular bail by this court in BP No. 1569/2025, 1581/2025 & 729/2026 on 18.11.2025, 20.11.2025 & 16.05.2026 and he has been rioting in judicial custody since 29.04.2026. Hence prayer for regular bail.

That prosecution case in short is that the informant PTC 864 Upendra Kumar, stating therein that on 15.05.2025, a dial 112 police team responded to a hostage and murder report involving Vibha Kumari and her mother in Gunja Bangara Krishnath Tola, Muzaffarpur. Upon arrival with local officials, the team found the report to be false. When the police team attempted to deescalate the situation, a large group of approximately 43 identified villagers and 50-60 unidentified individuals surrounded the vehicle, armed with sticks, rods and axes, the crowd attacked the officers and damaged the vehicle. During the confrontation, the attackers reportedly assaulted the personnel, including a female constable, and seized a service rifle and mobile phone. After arrival of the reinforcements, the situation was brought under control and the mother and daughter were questioned. Officers Upendra Kumar and Chandani Kumari sustained injuries during the incident and received medical treatment at PHC Paru.

On the other hand, the learned A.P.P. opposed.

Rival contentions of the parties were heard and the record was perused. On

perusal of the record and other things along with case diary, which transpires that petitioner named in FIR, and it appears that the informant of the case is police concern and the allegation against the petitioner is general and omnibus. There is no direct overt act found against the petitioner and earlier other co-accused persons have granted the benefit of regular bail by this court in BP No. 1569/2025, 1581/2025 & 729/2026 on 18.11.2025, 20.11.2025 & 16.05.2026 and he is in judicial custody since 23.05.2026.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances and also custody period of the accused person. I am of the opinion that the petitioner to grant the privilege of Bail. Hence, the accused petitioner is directed to be released on execution of a bond of Rs. 10,000/-with two sureties of the like amount with satisfaction of the learned trial court.

In the result, this regular bail petition of petitioner namely **Monu Kumar** in connection with Deoria PS Case No. 101/2025 is hereby **allowed.**
