1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioners/accused 1. Prince Kumar, S/o- Arun Kumar @ Arun Sah, 2. Arun Kumar, S/o- Radha Sah, 3. Kiran Devi, W/o- Arun Kumar @ Arun Sah, 4. Nikhil Kumar, S/o- Arun Kumar @ Arun Sah, 5. Tannu Kumari, D/o- Arun Kumar @ Arun Sah, 6. Anjali Devi, W/o- Raj Kumar @ Raj Kumar Sah, 7. Raj Kumar Gupta, S/o- Jailal Sah and 8. Awadhesh Kumar Gupta @ Awadhesh Kumar, S/o- Binod Gupta.
2. The Petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail under section 438 of the Cr.P.C. apprehending their arrest in Panapur Kariyat P.S. Case No. 77 of 2026, registered under sections 191(2), 303(2), 74, 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 126(2), 329(3), 329(4), 61(2), 352, 351(2) (3), 76 of the BNS.
3. Ld. counsel for the petitioners submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
4. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that they are innocent and have not committed any offence. That petitioners have got no criminal antecedents. The entire prosecution story is false and fabricated.
5. The case of the informant is that on 15.05.2026 around 11:45 Am while she was sitting outside her house, Prince Kumar came, abused her and pushed her on the ground. The accused also assaulted her and took away her mangalsutra.
6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.
7. Taking into account the nature of allegation against the petitioners and the fact that petitioners are first time offenders and there is case and counter case between the parties and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that

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the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the above named petitioners be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned subject to following conditions:-

- The petitioners shall co-operate with the investigating agency as well as in the trial, as and when required.
- The petitioners shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
