1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused 1. Md. Jahangir, S/o- Late Md. Aslam.
2. The Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS, apprehending his arrest in Sakra P.S. Case No. 225/2026, registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 76/303(2), 351(1), 352, 3(5) of the BNS.
3. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
4. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submit that he is innocent and has not committed any offence. That petitioner has got no criminal antecedents. The entire prosecution story is false and fabricated. Petitioner and informant are full brothers and there is land dispute between them.
5. The case of the informant is that on 08.04.2026 around 11 PM, Md. Jahangir entered the house of his daughter-in-law and tried to misbehave with her and when she raised an alarm, he went to her room and caught him. Thereafter, he was assaulted by the accused and other co-accused and accused Shahin Khatoon took away chain from his daughter-in-law.
6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.
7. Taking into account the nature of allegation against the petitioner and the fact that there is case and counter case between the parties and also the fact that petitioner is first time offender and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let

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the petitioner 1. Md. Jahangir, S/o- Late Md. Aslam be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned subject to following conditions:-

- The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigating agency as well as in the trial, as and when required.
- The petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
