1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioners/accused 1. Virendra Ram, S/o Late Vishwanath Ram @ Late Vishu Ram 2. Sunita Devi, W/o Virendra Ram and 3. Abhishek Kumar, S/o Virendra Ram.
2. The Petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail under section 482 of the BNSS apprehending their arrest in Dewariya P.S. Case No. 157/2026, registered under section 96, 137(2) BNS.
3. Ld. counsel for the petitioners submit that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
4. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that they are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case due to previous enmity and grudge. That the petitioners have got no criminal antecedents. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that prosecution story is totally false and concocted.
5. Prosecution case in brief is that the daughter of informant is missing since 26.05.2026. Later, the informant came to know that one Vivek Kumar took away his daughter and when the informant went to his house to inquire about the same, his parents became furious.
6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.
7. On perusal of record, including the TCR, it transpires that victim girl has been recovered and after recovery, her statement has been recorded u/s 183 of the BNSS, wherein she has not levelled any allegation against these three petitioners. In fact, the victim girl has not whispered even the names of these petitioners, in her said statement. The present petitioners happen to be merely the family members of the prime accused namely Vivek Kumar. The victim girl has also submitted in her statement under section 183 of the BNSS that

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she was not kidnapped by any person. As per para no. 3 of the anticipatory bail application, the petitioners have got no criminal antecedents.

8. Considering the above mentioned facts & circumstances of the case including victim's statement u/s 183 of the BNSS, the prayer of anticipatory bail is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of their arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the above named three petitioners be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, each, to the satisfaction of learned court concerned and subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.
