Bail Petition- 914/2026

06.07.2026 A petition for bail dt. 08.06.2026 along with power and certified copy of documents has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely **Aman Kumar**, who is in judicial custody since 23.04.2026 in connection with Katra P.S. case no. 111/2026 dt. 22.04.2026 U/s 140(2)/3(5) of B.N.S.

Ld. Counsel of the behalf of petitioner Dr. Vikash Kumar and ld. Chief Prosecutor on behalf of state are present before the court.

The brief fact is case is that the informant received a call on 21.04.2026 at about 02:40 P.M. from the mobile number of Ravi Kumar Ravi and she was told that Ravi has been kidnapped and she was demanded Rs 3 Lakh and was threatened that her son Ravi Kumar will be killed if the demand is not fulfilled. Though the phone number was of her son but the person taking was not her son. She got scared of and she sent Rs 1 Lakh through Phone Pay on the mobile no of Ravi Kumar Ravi. Again in the morning of 22.04.2026 a scanner was sent in the name of Rampravesh Kumar and it was threatened that if 2 Lakh Rs is not sent till 11 A.M. her son Ravi Kumar Ravi will be killed. She has suspicion that Rampravesh Kumar and his friend have kidnapped her son for ransom.

Learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and he has committed no offence as alleged in the FIR. Petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 23.04.2026. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. He has been falsely implicated in this false and fabricated case. The entire allegation leveled against the petitioner is wrong, false and cooked up story. The petitioner is neither named in the FIR nor any thing has been recovered from his possession. The petitioner is a student. There is not chance of his absconding or tampering with the evidence.

Learned Chief Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. From the perusal of case record it appears that the demand of ransom was made from the mobile no of Ravi Kumar Ravi, the son of informant. It has been submitted that the petitioner is a student. He is not named in the FIR . Chrgsheet has already been submitted in this case against this petitioner. Nothing has been mentioned in the case diary regarding the criminal

antecedent of this petitioner. However, the petitioner has himself mentioned in para 3 of his bail petitioner that he has got no criminal antecedent. The petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 23.04.2026. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case I am inclined to grant the bail to the petitioner. Hence, the prayer of bail of the is hereby **allowed**.

Accordingly petitioner, **Aman Kumar** is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court below on conditions that one of the bailors must be close relative of the petitioner.
