- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioners/accused namely, **1. Shivchandra Mahto, S/o late Ramchalitra Mahto, 2. Mamita Devi, W/o Sonelal Mahto and 3. Nelam Devi @ Lilam Devi, W/o Ashok Mahto.**
- (2) The Petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS apprehending their arrest in Baruraj P.S.Case No.110/2026, registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 74, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3) and 3(5) of the BNS.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioners submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (4) Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that they are innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged in the F.I.R. It has further submitted that this case is nothing but counter blast of Baruraj P.S.Case No.107/2026 filed by petitioner no.2 Mamita Devi. The allegations against the petitioners are omnibus and general. Petitioners have got no criminal antecedents. Accordingly, learned Counsel has prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
- (5) Learned P.P. on the other hand has opposed the prayer.
- (6) Having heard both sides, I have perused the case records. It is evident that petitioners have been named as accused in this case, which has been registered on the basis of written complaint of one Shashi Ranjan Kumar. It is alleged that due to some previous dispute, the above named petitioners and

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other co-accused, reached the house of informant and assaulted informant's father Harishchandra Rai with iron rod, as a result of which, he sustained fractured injury in his right leg and also sustained tear injury on his head. It is further alleged that Sonelal Mahto also inflicted farsa blow, causing injury on the head of informant. It is also alleged that the accused persons further assaulted the family members of informant and snatched Rs.5000/- from his pocket.

- (7) On perusal of record including the F.I.R., it appears that there is omnibus and general allegation against these petitioners. No specific overt-act is alleged against them. It further appears that the case filed by the petitioners side is early in the point of time. As per para no. 3 of the ABP, the petitioners have got no criminal history.
- (8) Considering the above facts & circumstances and the nature of allegation against the petitioners, the prayer of anticipatory bail is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of their arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the petitioners namely, **1. Shivchandra Mahto, S/o late Ramchalitra Mahto, 2. Mamita Devi, W/o Sonelal Mahto and 3. Nelam Devi @ Lilam Devi, W/o Ashok Mahto.** be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned, subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.
