- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Nemi Rai @ Naufi Rai, S/o Raghuvir Rai.
- (2) The petitioner is apprehending his arrest under section 482(2) of the BNSS, in connection with Turki PS Case No. 86/2026, registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 109, 74, 3(5) of the BNS.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved either before this court or the Hon'ble High Court, Patna.
- (4) The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the allegation levelled against the petitioner is false and concocted and he does not have any criminal antecedent. It has further been submitted that other petitioners of this ABP have already been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 22.04.2026 and the petition of this petitioner remain pending awaiting injury report. Now, injury report has been received and the injuries have been found simple in nature.
- (5) The case of the informant Sagar Rai is that, on 10.03.2026 around 08:10 PM, the accused 9 in number who are his neighbours started assaulting them. Meanwhile, Naufi Rai allegedly hit him with a rod injuring the same and when his wife came to his help, she was hit with a lathi and his son with brick.
- (6) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

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- (7) It appears that the injury report submitted by the P.P. is on record. It appears that the injury caused to informant Sagar Rai has been opined to be simple in nature by the doctor caused by hard and blunt substance.
- (8) Taking note of these facts alongwith circumstances of nature as well as nature of injury sustained by informant and the fact that other petitioners of this ABP have already been granted anticipatory bail, let the petitioner namely, Nemi Rai @ Naufi Rai, S/o Raghuvir Rai in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks period from the date of communication of this order be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned court subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.
