- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioners/accused namely, **1. Bipin Chaudhary, 2. Rohit Chaudhary, both sons of Binod Chaudhary, 3. Binod Chaudhary, 4. Manoj Chaudhary, 5. Mukesh Chaudhary, sons of late Yogendra Chaudhary, 6. Rajdeo Chaudhary, S/o late Bhagya Narain Chaudhary, 7. Manish Chaudhary, S/o Rajdeo Chaudhary and 8. Raman Chaudhary @ Raman Kumar, S/o Raj Kishore Chaudhary.**
- (2) The Petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS apprehending their arrest in Sahebganj P.S.Case No.467/2026, registered under sections 190, 191(2), 115(2), 303(2), 351(2), 352(2), 304, 309, 331, 332, 74, 75 and 3(5) of B.N.S.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioners submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (4) Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that they are innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged in the F.I.R. It has further submitted that this case is nothing but counter blast of Sahebganj P.S.Case No.333/2026 filed by petitioner no.1 Bipin Chaudhary. The allegations against the petitioners are omnibus and general. Petitioners have got no criminal antecedents, except petitioner no.3 Binod Chaudhary, who has one criminal antecedent, bearing Sahebganj P.S.Case No.107/2017. Accordingly, learned Counsel has prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
- (5) Learned P.P. on the other hand has opposed the prayer.
- (6) Having heard both sides, I have perused the case records. It is evident that petitioners have been named as accused in this case, which has been

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registered on the basis of complaint filed in court by one Janardan Singh. It is alleged that at the relevant time, all the petitioners and other co-accused, reached the house of informant, where Tilak Ceremony of his son was going on and Bipin Chaudhary snatched gold chain from the neck of informant's son and all the accused persons created nuisance by entering into house and committed indecent act with the female members.

- (7) On perusal of record including the F.I.R., it appears that there is omnibus and general allegation against these petitioners. No specific overt-act is alleged against them. The allegation of snatching gold chain is super addition. It further appears that the case filed by the petitioners side is early in the point of time.
- (8) Considering the above facts & circumstances and the nature of allegation against the petitioners, the prayer of anticipatory bail is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of their arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the petitioners namely, **1. Bipin Chaudhary, 2. Rohit Chaudhary, both sons of Binod Chaudhary, 3. Binod Chaudhary, 4. Manoj Chaudhary, 5. Mukesh Chaudhary, sons of late Yogendra Chaudhary, 6. Rajdeo Chaudhary, S/o late Bhagya Narain Chaudhary, 7. Manish Chaudhary, S/o Rajdeo Chaudhary and 8. Raman Chaudhary @ Raman Kumar, S/o Raj Kishore Chaudhary** be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned, subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.
