10-02-2025	<p>Record is put up for order after completion of inquiry u/s 202 of the CrPC.</p> <p>Perused the case record. On perusal it transpires that this complaint case no. 1190/2024 has been filed by Mst. Surti Devi against three accused persons U/s 126(2)/127(2)/329(4)/115(2)/109/303(2)/352/351(3) of the BNS and 3/4 of Daain Act, before the Id. court of A.C.J.M-1 Muzaffarpur (West) on 27-07-2024 which was transferred u/s 192 of the CrPC to this court on 28-10-2024.</p> <p>The complainant examined herself on oath on 28-10-2024 and has produced three witnesses namely Harishankar Singh as inquiry witness no.1, Amrita Devi as inquiry witness no.2, and Narayan Singh as inquiry witness no.3, in support of her case, who have been examined u/s 202 of the CrPC.</p> <p>On the basis of material available in the complaint, S.A. and testimony of inquiry witnesses, this court finds sufficient material to make out prima facie case u/s 126(2)/115(2)/303(2)/352/351(3) of the BNS and 3/4 of Daain Act, against all named persons in the complaint 1. Urmila Devi, 2. Vikash Kumar, 3. Amit Kumar. There is no sufficient material available on record to attract other section mentioned in the complaint.</p>
