	13-03-2026	<p>The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Naresh Chaudhary@Naresh Kumar, S/o Late Govind Chaudhary, who is in custody since 26.12.2025 in connection with Deepnagar P.S. Case No. 525/2025, u/s. 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S.</p> <p>Prosecution story, in brief, is that informant Vivek Kumar gave a written petition at Deepnagar P.S. in which he has mentioned that on 24.11.2025 at 5:19 P.M. Dhanraj Kumar called on informant's mobile number 7301135918 from mobile number 8235855173 and asked him to come near Om Washing Centre. As he came out of the house on his motorcycle to go, he saw that three unknown boys were standing there and when he reached near Om Washing Centre, the informant's motorcycle was stopped by Manish Kumar, Naresh Chaudhary, Dhanraj Kumar along with three other unknown persons and Dhanraj Kumar started abusing and Manish Kumar with the intention of killing hit him on the head with the butt of the pistol due to which the head got cracked and blood started flowing and he assaulted informant on the nose due to which the nose got cut. Naresh Chaudhary also started hitting informant and snatched Rs. 8000/- from the pocket and the golden chain from the neck. On these facts, Deepnagar P.S. Case No. 525/2025, dated 24.11.2025 was registered against accused-petitioner and other accused persons under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S.</p> <p>Heard the learned counsel Shri Subesh Kumar for the petitioner as well as learned A.P.P. Shri Sunil Kumar Sinha on behalf of the State.</p> <p>It has been submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner that no bail application on behalf of the petitioner either anticipatory or regular was earlier filed either before this learned Court or the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. It has been further submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in the present case on account of long drawn previous enmity. The alleged allegation levelled against the petitioner is false, fabricated and concocted. The allegation of theft has been purposely added in the present case to make the case non-bailable. The petitioner has no concern with any other co-accused of the present case and even he does not know them. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and the informant of this case filed a false case, Laheri P.S. Case No. 318/25, which has been in retaliation to the Complaint Case No. 148C/25. Section 109 of the B.N.S. has got no application in the present case. The petitioner is a courier boy and on that date he was busy in performing his duty. He also said that he is in custody since 26.12.2025. On these facts, he has prayed that the petitioner be granted regular bail.</p> <p>Learned A.P.P. vehemently opposed the bail petition.</p>

	<u>Contd.</u> 13-03-2026	<p>Heard both the parties. Perused the case record and other relevant papers, it appears that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 26.12.2025. From perusal of the case diary, at paragraph no. 2, there is restatement of informant. At paragraph no. 8, 9 & 10 of the case diary, all witnesses have said that after seeing the gathering they stopped there and saw that accused Manish Kumar, Naresh Chaudhary and Dhanraj along with other three persons were assaulting the informant. There is no specific allegation against this petitioner. However, at paragraph no. 52, there is injury report in which the Doctor has found injury as (i) Abrasion over nose, (ii) Abrasion over forehead and (iii) Abrasion over scalp. It has been advised that NCCT Brain has done and no significant abnormality is seen. So, the doctor has found the injury to be simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. At paragraph no. 66, no CCTV camera was found. Above all, chargesheet has been filed in this case. The petitioner is in jail custody since 26.12.2025 which is more than two and a half month.</p> <p>Considering the abovesaid facts and circumstances of this case, period of custody and injury report, the bail petition of the accused-petitioner Naresh Chaudhary @ Naresh Kumar stands allowed with submission of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Lower Court.</p> <p align="right">(Dictated & corrected)</p> <p align="right">Sd/- (Akhauri Abhishek Sahay) Addl.
