	15-04-2026	<p>The anticipatory bail petition dated 21.01.2026 received to this Court on 27.01.2026 filed on behalf of the petitioners, namely, (1) Shyam Yadav and (2) Shankar Yadav, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Bind P.S. Case No. 01/2026 registered u/s 137(2), 140(2) of the B.N.S., has been placed before me for order after hearing, a copy of it has already been supplied to the learned Addl.P.P.</p> <p>Heard the learned counsel Sri Krishna Kumar for the petitioners as well as the learned Addl.P.P. Sri Amir Singh on behalf of the State.</p> <p>The prosecution story as per the written report of the informant Anil Kumar, in brief, is that on 30.12.2025 about 08:00 P.M. the informant's daughter Kalpana Kumari aged about 14 years was missing. He enquired from the villagers and family members on his own but on that day nothing could be traced out about her. After that on 31.12.2025 in the morning he got the information that Monu Yadav has taken away the daughter of the informant by giving her temptation. Then, the informant went to the house of Monu Yadav and talked to his father Shyam Yadav and his brother Shankar @ Madan Yadav, at first they kept denying it, but later they said to do whatever he wants to do, they would not return his daughter.</p> <p>The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence rather they have falsely been dragged and implicated in this case. The petitioners are living separately from Monu Yadav and they are the farmers. The petitioner Shyam Yadav is an old man. He further submitted that they are having no criminal history. On these facts, he prayed that the petitioners be granted anticipatory bail.</p> <p>The learned Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.</p> <p>Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered U/s 137(2), 140(2) of the B.N.S and the case of the prosecution is that the accused Monu Yadav took away the informant's minor daughter by giving her temptation. The petitioner Shyam Yadav is the father of the accused Monu Yadav and the petitioner Shankar Yadav is the brother of the accused Monu Yadav and the allegation against them is that when the informant went to their house then they said that they would not return his daughter. Also, para-31 of the case diary reflects that the petitioner are not having any criminal antecedent.</p>
