	26-03-2026	<p>The anticipatory bail petition dated 03.02.2026 received to this Court on 06.02.2026 filed on behalf of petitioners namely, (1) Md. Nehal and (2) Md. Manglu, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Laheri P.S. Case No. 255/2017, dated 20.06.2017 registered U/s. 457, 380 I.P.C, has been placed before me for order after hearing, a copy of it has already been supplied to the learned Addl. P.P.</p> <p>Heard the learned counsel Shri Ravish Kumar for petitioners as well as learned A.P.P. Shri Sunil Kumar Sinha on behalf of the State.</p> <p>The prosecution story as per the written report of the informant Kushal Kumar Rastogi, in brief, is that on 16.06.2017 at about 9 AM all the family members including informant had gone to Islampur and returned on 19.06.2017 at about 6:30A.M.. As soon as he entered into his house, he saw that the door was opened and the articles were scattered. The jewellery and cash rupees twenty five thousand were looted by the thief.</p> <p>The learned counsel for petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence rather they have falsely been dragged and implicated in the present case due to enmity. There is no recovery from the possession of the petitioners. The petitioners are not named in the F.I.R. The petitioners are the labours. The petitioners name has come in the confessional statement of the accused Md. Rais. The petitioners have got no any criminal antecedent. On these facts, he prayed that the petitioners be granted anticipatory bail.</p> <p>The learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioners.</p> <p>Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered U/s 457, 380 I.P.C against the unknown accused persons and the name of the petitioners sprung up in the confessional statement of Md. Rais. It further transpires that nothing has been recovered so far from the possession of the petitioners though the F.I.R. was registered in the year 2017. Further, it also appears that nothing has been recovered relating to this case so far from the possession of Md. Rais against whom it has been alleged during investigation that he was dealing with stolen property. Also, it has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners during argument that the petitioners are not having any criminal antecedent and for that they are giving affidavit before the Court.</p>
