	08-04-2026	<p>The anticipatory bail petition dated 11.02.2026 received to this Court on 26.02.2026 filed on behalf of the petitioners, namely, (1) Chunchun Kumar and (2) Munchun Kumar who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Asthawan P.S. Case No. 28/2026 registered u/s 140(2), 140(3), 3(5) of the B.N.S., has been placed before me for order after hearing, a copy of it has already been supplied to the learned Addl.P.P.</p> <p>Heard the learned counsel Sri Pal for the petitioners as well as the learned Addl.P.P. Sri Amir Singh on behalf of the State.</p> <p>The prosecution story as per the written report of the informant Dharmendra Kumar, P.S.I., Asthawan P.S., in brief, is that on 25.01.2026 at about 07:30 P.M., he received information that the accused persons of Asthawan P.S. Case No. 315/25, namely, Chunchun Kumar and Munchun Kumar are sitting with their father in a Black Scorpio near the Durga Temple, at a short distance, After informing the senior officer, informant proceeded for verification of the information and necessary action. When he reached there, he saw that a black Scorpio is parked there and when he asked Chunchun Kumar to come out from the vehicle after opening the gate, he started the vehicle and tried to flee away. He also got into the vehicle, informed the S.H.O. and attempted to arrest him. But the accused Chunchun Kumar drove the vehicle rashly to his village, Badepur and parked there. As soon as the vehicle parked, two people were already present there along with the accused Vinod Yadav and they tried to free Chunchun Kumar and Munchun Kumar. The father of the accused Chunchun Kumar and Munchun Kumar made a video and asked to get it viraled. Seeing the police vehicles, they all fled away.</p> <p>The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence rather they have falsely been dragged and implicated in the present case. The petitioners were accused of the Asthawan P.S. case No. 315/2025 and informant of the present case was I.O. of Asthawan P.S. Case No. 315/2025 and the I.O. has made them accused in this case due to non-fulfillment of his illegal demands. No such type of occurrence has been occurred as alleged in the F.I.R. He further submitted that they are having criminal history. On these facts, he prayed that the petitioners be granted anticipatory bail.</p> <p>The learned Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.</p> <p>Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered U/s 140(2), 140(3), 3(5) of the B.N.S and the allegation against the petitioners is that the informant received an information that the petitioners who are the accused of Asthawan</p>
