The present application for bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner, namely, Baliram Paswan, who is in judicial custody since 03.02.2026 in connection with Asthawan P.S. Case No. 34/2026 registered for the offences punishable u/s 126(2), 115(2), 351(2), 352, 109(2) of the B.N.S.

Heard the learned lawyer for the petitioner as well as the Ld. P.P. for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that earlier the petitioner has not filed any regular or anticipatory bail either before this learned court or before the Hon'ble High Court. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedents. Learned counsel further submits that the allegations are false and the petitioner has committed no offence. All sections are bailable except Section 109(1) of the B.N.S. but the same will have no application to the facts of the case. The allegation is that of assault with a piece of brick, there is no allegation of repetition of blow and the occurrence is said to have been taken place in the spur of the moment. The present case is a case of false implication and the petitioner had not assaulted Rani Kumari alleged in the F.I.R. The children were playing and in that course Rani Kumari fell down sustained injury. The petitioner is an old man aged about 60 years. The case has also been compromised, a joint compromise petition has also been filed with the bail application. Hence, the petitioner be granted bail.

The Ld. P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

The prosecution case, in brief, based on the fardbeyan of the informant, Lalita Devi is as follows:- On 02.02.2026 at about 12:00 hrs., minor son of informant namely Rajan Kumar was abused and assaulted by the petitioner, Baliram Paswan and when the daughter of informant namely Rani Kumari went there to pacify the matter then she was assaulted by the petitioner on her forehead with brick causing she sustained injury and got unconscious. The petitioner also gave threatening for dire consequences, if they will lodge a case.

Heard the learned lawyer for the petitioner as well as the Ld. P.P. for the State, and perused the case record as well as the case diary from para 1 to 47. The allegation against the petitioner is that he has abused and assaulted the minor children of the informant with brick. At para 2 of the case diary, there is statement of the informant, who has fully supported the case of the prosecution. The witnesses at para 3, 6, 7 and 37 of the case diary, have also supported the case of the prosecution. At para 42 of the case diary, there is injury report, which shows that the injury is simple in nature on the side of the forehead.

It is worth to mention here that the case has been compromised between the parties, a joint compromise application has also been filed with the record and the informant also appeared before the court and said that she has compromised the matter with the accused and



does not want to continue with the case.

Though, the case is non-compoundable in nature, the informant herself does not want to continue with the case, it is clear what will be the fate of the case. Moreover, from the perusal of para 43 of the case diary, it is evident that there is no criminal antecedent against the petitioner and the petitioner has already been charge sheeted vide para 47 of the case diary and he is in custody since 03.02.2026.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner and hence, the same is hereby **allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below.
