	02-04-2026	<p>The present petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner Mohan Chaudhary, who is in judicial custody since 13.12.2025 in connection with Sare P.S. Case No. 185/2025 registered U/s-80(2)/3(5) of the B.N.S., is pressed today.</p> <p>The prosecution story as per the written report of the informant Jitan Chaudhary, in brief, is that the marriage of informant's daughter namely Rinki Kumari was solemnised with Mohan Chaudhary on 08.05.2025 according to Hindu rites and rituals. After few days of marriage the in-laws of his daughter namely Yogendra Chaudhary, Mahangi Devi, Suresh Chaudhary and Mohan Chaudhary started torturing her for demand of Rs. 1 lakh as dowry and they said that the money is needed for getting the land registered and if she does not bring the money from her father, then they will kill her. It has been further alleged that on 09.12.2025 at about 4:00 P.M. the informant received the information from the villagers that his daughter Rinki Kumari has died. When he reached at the matrimonial home of his daughter, he saw that the father-in-law Yogendra Chaudhary, mother-in-law Mahangi Devi, Bhaisur Suresh Chaudhary and husband Mohan Chaudhary have killed his daughter by strangulation.</p> <p>Heard the learned counsel Shri Sonu Kumar for the petitioner as well as the learned A.P.P. Shri Sunil Kumar Sinha on behalf of the State.</p> <p>It has been submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in the present case only on the basis of the statement given by one unknown person. The petitioner happens to be the husband of the deceased Rinki Kumari. The informant is not an eye witness of the alleged occurrence. There was no demand of dowry and deceased was never subjected to cruelty by any person. The deceased Rinki Kumari was suffering from mental disease and she was taking jarubuti(Herbs) and on 09.12.2025 in the morning deceased Rinki Kumari was alone in her house and her husband and all family members had gone out of the house for some urgent work and in the meantime, deceased Rinki Kumari committed suicide by hanging. The petitioner has go no any criminal antecedent. He also submits that the petitioner is in custody since 13.12.2025. On these facts, he has prayed that the petitioner be granted regular bail.</p> <p>The learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer for the bail.</p> <p>Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered u/s 80(2)/3(5) of the B.N.S. and the petitioner is the husband of the deceased and the allegation against the petitioner is that he along with his father, mother and brother committed murder of his wife by strangulation for demand of Rs. 1 lakh as dowry. It further transpires that the deceased died unnaturally at her matrimonial home within seven years of marriage. Also, the postmortem report reflects that the cause of death is asphyxia due to strangulation.</p>
