	12-03-2026	<p>The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Solanki@Anshu@ Abhinash Kumar, son of Uday Yadav, who is in custody since 20.08.2025 in connection with Laheri P.S. Case No. 8/2025, U/s. 304(2) of the B.N.S.</p> <p>Prosecution story, in brief, is that the informant Gulshan Kumar gave a written petition to the S.H.O. of Laheri P.S. alleging therein that on 07.01.2025 at about 12:30 O' Clock, informant was going to Ramchandrapur Bus stand. In the meantime, two boys started talking with him near Satyapal Hotel and in course of talking one boy snatched mobile of informant having Jio Sim No. 6206192060 and given to another boy and they fled away. On hulla, vicinity people assemble there, police also came there and caught one boy. The boy who was caught told the name as Niraj Kumar, son of Raja Ram Mahto, resident of mohalla Kamruddinganj, Police station Laheri and he also revealed the name of fled boy as Kaila, son of Bipin Paswan of village Sathopur, Police station Deepnagar, District Nalanda. On these facts, Laheri P.S. Case No. 8/2025, dated 07.01.2025 was registered against petitioner and other accused persons under Section 304(2) of the B.N.S.</p> <p>Heard the learned counsel Shri Barun Kumar for the petitioner as well as learned A.P.P. Shri Sunil Kumar Sinha on behalf of the State.</p> <p>It has been submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner that no bail application on behalf of the petitioner either anticipatory or regular was earlier moved either before this learned Court or the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. It has been further submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated by the police in this present case.</p> <p>The petitioner is not named in the FIR. The name of the petitioner came in confessional statement of other co-accused namely Mehul Raj Chauhan @ Ranchu. Nothing has been recovered from the physical possession of the petitioner. The charge sheet has been submitted in this case against the petitioner and there is no evidence against the petitioner to involve in this case but only on confessional statement he has been remanded in this case. The FIR named accused Niraj Kumar and Kaila has been allowed bail vide B.P. No. 199/25 and B.P. No. 1582/25. The co-accused Mehul Kumar, from his mouth the name of the petitioner has come and Karan Kumar has been allowed bail vide B.P. No. 1198/25 and B.P. No. 1574/25 respectively by this Court. The petitioner's case stands on better footing. Considering this, the bail petition of the accused-petitioner may be allowed.</p>

Chargesheet has been submitted against the petitioner and others. There was no T.I.P. with respect to this petitioner. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner.
