| | 24-03-2026 | <p>The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of petitioner Ravi Kumar Verma, who is in custody since 19.01.2026 in connection with Bihar Sharif P.S. Case No. 33/2026 registered for the offences punishable U/s.-305(a), 3(5), 317(2) of the B.N.S..</p> <p>Prosecution case, in brief, is that informant Malti Kumari gave a written application to the SHO, Bihar Sharif alleging therein that on 15.01.2026 the informant and her husband went outside the house to earn their livelihood and when they return to their house in the evening then, they saw that Godrej is open and saw that gold ornaments worth of Rs. 7 lakhs are not there and thereafter the informant asked forcibly to her son, Satyam Kumar then he disclosed that he handed over all the ornaments to Ravi Kumar Verma and Abhi Kumar @ Chutru and thereafter, the informant claimed that the alleged persons have taken away the alleged ornaments by alluring her son and took all the jewellery paying less value. On these facts, Bihar Sharif P.S. Case No. 33/2026, dated 19.01.2026 was registered against the petitioner and other accused person under Sections 305(a), 3(5), 317(2) of the B.N.S..</p> <p>Heard the learned counsel Shri Sanjay Kumar for petitioner as well as learned A.P.P. Shri Sunil Kumar Sinha on behalf of the State.</p> <p>It has been submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of petitioner that no any bail petition has ever been filed before this learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court. The petitioner has got no any criminal antecedent. He is in judicial custody since 19.01.2026. He is quite innocent and has committed no offence rather has been falsely implicated in the present case due to ulterior motive and mohalla politics. There is delay of four days in lodging F.I.R. the date of occurrence is said to be 15.01.2026 and information given to the Bihar P.S. on 19.01.2026. From perusal of arrest memo and seizure list in this case, it is clear that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. So, section 317(2) of the B.N.S. will not applicable against the petitioner. As per FIR ornaments from her godrej was theft by her son Satyam Kumar so section 305(a) will not applicable against the petitioner and Satyam Kumar is not an accused in this case. The petitioner has got no shop of ornaments at any place. There is no confessional statement given before the Police. The petitioner is a substantial man and there is no chance of his absconding and is ready to give sureties to the satisfaction of the Court. So whatever allegations are levelled against petitioner by informant are merely on the basis of surmises and conjectures. On these facts, he has prayed that petitioner be granted regular bail.</p> <p>Learned A.P.P. vehemently opposed the bail petition.</p> <p>Heard both the parties. Perused the case record and other relevant papers, it appears that at paragraph no. 4, 5, 9, of the case diary, all witnesses have supported the case of prosecution. At paragraph no. 20 of the case diary, there is re-statement of the informant wherein she has fully supported the case of the prosecution The allegation against the petitioner is only that he purchased gold</p> | |
