	26-03-2026	<p>The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Kamlesh Kumar, who is in custody since 08.01.2026 in connection with Katrisarai P.S. Case No. 14/2026, u/s. 316(2), 318(4), 319(2), 336(3), 338, 340(2), 3(5), 61(2) of the B.N.S. &amp; Sections 66(C), 66(D) I.T. Act, is pressed today.</p> <p>The prosecution story as per the typed report of the informant Aditya Kumar, PSI, Katrisarai P.S., in brief, is that on 07.01.2026, the informant alongwith raiding party arrived at the village of Maira Barith and found some people sitting in groups at various locations. They were surrounded and upon seeing the police, they started running in different directions and they were apprehended. They disclosed their names as : 1. Manoj Singh, 2. Omkari Kumar, 3. Deep Kumar, 4. Kamlesh Kumar, 5. Pappu Yadav, 6. Shubham Kumar, 7. Rajeev Kumar, 8. Sagar Paswan, 9. Golu Kumar, and 10. Sanjay Kumar. Upon search, (1) Sagar Paswan was found in possession of three Android mobile phones, containing whatsapp applications consists of a loan approval letter in the name of PM Mudra Loan, several fake document scanners, and ₹13,500/-. (2) Three Android mobile phones with WhatsApp enabled, loan approval letter in the name of PM Mudra Loan, many fake document scanners and Rs. 3700/- were found from the possession of Rajeev Kumar. (3) A mobile phone with Dhani Finance loan advertisement on WhatsApp DP and many fake document scanners were found from Manoj Singh. (4) One mobile phone was recovered from Omkari Kumar. (5) Two mobile phones with WhatsApp DP enabled, advertisement of Meso online service and loan approval letter in the name of PM Mudra Loan and many fake document scanners were found from Deepak Kumar. (6) Two mobile phones were recovered from Kamlesh Kumar, on one of which the WhatsApp DP had an advertisement of Bajaj Finance and on the other the WhatsApp DP had an advertisement of Dhani Finance and On the other, an advertisement of Dhani Finance was found on the WhatsApp DP operated by him. PM Mudra Loan approval letter and many fake document scanners were found in the WhatsApp of both the mobiles. (7) Two mobile phones were recovered from Pappu Kumar in which an advertisement of Nidhi Capital was found on the WhatsApp DP operated by him and loan approval letter in the name of Dhani Finance Pvt Ltd and many scanners were found in WhatsApp. (8) Two mobile phones were recovered from Shubham Kumar in which an advertisement of SBI Finance was found on the WhatsApp DP operated by him and loan approval letter in the name of Mudra Loan and many fake document scanners were found and Rs. 6500/- were also found. (9) A mobile phone containing an SBI loan related advertisement and a fake document scanner was found on Golu Kumar's WhatsApp account. Facebook accounts were created in 12 different names, containing obscene photos and videos of girls, which were sent to innocent people stating to earn money by impregnating them and earn money. (10) A mobile phone was recovered from Sanjay Kumar. On being asked, the accused persons could not produce any documents. The recovered items were seized and accordingly the seizure list was prepared and the apprehended individuals were arrested.</p> <p>Heard the learned counsel Shri Kumar Narendra for the petitioner as well as learned A.P.P. 	<u>Contd.</u> 26-03-2026	<p>the State.</p> <p>It has been submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case by the police at the instance of his enemies with ulterior motives. The alleged prosecution story is false, concocted and motivated. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged occurrence and nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and the police wrongly shown the alleged two mobiles from the possessions of the petitioner and from the alleged mobile petitioner has no concern. There is no allegation against the petitioner that he facilitated any person to commit fraud. The petitioner has got no any criminal antecedent. The petitioner is in custody since 08.01.2026. On these facts, he has prayed that the petitioner be granted regular bail.</p> <p>The learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer for bail.</p> <p>Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered u/s. 316(2), 318(4), 319(2), 336(3), 338, 340(2), 3(5), 61(2) of the B.N.S. &amp; Sections 66(C), 66(D) I.T. Act and it also transpires from the case diary received for hearing of this bail petition that no one has complained about cheating or for any other offence including cyber crime during investigation. As per para-36 of the case diary the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedent. Moreover, the petitioner is in judicial custody since 08.01.2026.</p> <p>Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner <b>Kamlesh Kumar</b> is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court subject to condition that the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation/ trial.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">(Dictated &amp; corrected) Sd/- <b>(Khyati Singh)</b> Addl.
