**Order**


The present revision petition has been filed by the revisionists Ravi Kumar, Birendra Kumar @ Birendra Prasad and Ruby Kumari @ Ru'by Devi against the impugned order dated 04.08.2025 passed by Sri Raja Sah, Learned J.M.- 1<sup>st</sup> Class(VII), Biharsharif, Nalanda in Complaint Case No. 107(C) of 2024 to set aside the aforesaid order dated 04.08.2025.

From perusal of record, it appears that the case record is fixed for admission but the revision petition has been filed with a delay of 126 days(about four months). An application for condonation of delay has been moved, however, no satisfactory or sufficient explanation has been furnished for the inordinate delay in approaching the Court. It is well settled that though the provisions relating to limitation may be applied with some latitude in criminal matters, the delay cannot be condoned as a matter of course. The petitioner has failed to disclose any bona fide or convincing reason explaining each day's delay. In the absence of sufficient cause, the application for condonation of delay is liable to be rejected.

Therefore, this criminal revision application being barred by the law of limitation is hereby **dismissed at the admission stage itself.**
