(1) This Anticipatory Bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely 1. Parveen Kumar @ Boby Kumar, S/o- Dharendra Yadav, resident of Village- Lakhicak, P.S.- Noorsarai, District-Nalanda in connection with Deepnagar P.S. case No. 91/2026 registered U/S- 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(3) B.N.S. <u>PROSECUTION CASE</u> (2) Prosecution case, in brief, is that on 11th January 2026 at about 7:30 AM, when Boby Kumar came to the shop of the informant's husband and tried to steal money from the cash box, the informant's husband protested. Thereupon, Boby Kumar pointed a pistol at him and took away ₹15,000/- and a gold chain. It is further alleged that he assaulted the informant's husband with the butt of the pistol on his head and nose. <u>SUBMISSION OF THE COUNSEL OF THE PARTIES</u> (3) The learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed that anticipatory bail may be granted to the petitioner and has submitted as under: ● That the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence. ● That he has not filed any anticipatory or regular bail petition earlier before this Court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. ● That the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. ● That the petitioner is a government employee and is working as a postman. That Section 109 BNS is not attracted in the present case. (4) On the other hand, the learned APP has vehemently opposed the bail petition and submitted that the offence is serious in nature and, therefore, the petitioner does not deserve the benefit of anticipatory bail.	

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MATERIAL ON RECORD AND OBSERVATIONS

(5) From the perusal of the record, it transpires that the informant and the witnesses have supported the prosecution case. The injury report shows that the injured had sustained the following injuries:

- Abrasion over the left side of the nose measuring about $\frac{1}{2}$ cm $\times$ $\frac{1}{4}$ cm.
- Abrasion over the left eyebrow measuring about $\frac{1}{2}$ cm $\times$ $\frac{1}{4}$ cm.
- Abrasion over the frontal region of the scalp measuring about 1 cm $\times$ $\frac{1}{2}$ cm.
- Abrasion over the left pinna measuring about $\frac{1}{2}$ cm $\times$ $\frac{1}{4}$ cm.

The injuries are stated to be simple in nature.

(6) Considering the simple nature of the injuries, the anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**, and the petitioner is directed to be released on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from the date of this order.
