	06-04-2026	The present petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner Putu Yadav, who is in judicial custody since 29.01.2026 in connection with Harnaut P.S. Case No. 46/2021 registered U/s-392 I.P.C., is pressed today. The prosecution story as per the written report of the informant Manoranjan Prasad, in brief, is that on 01.02.2021 at about 8 P.M. he was going from Harnaut to his house Mishu. On the way, four unknown persons stopped his bike near Basti village and took out his gold chain and Rs. 5,000/-. After that they fled away. Heard the learned counsel Shri Ashok Kumar for the petitioner as well as the learned A.P.P. Shri Sunil Kumar Sinha on behalf of the State. It has been submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been dragged and implicated in the present case due village politics and due to land dispute. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. His name has come in the confessional statement of co-accused Dharendra Kumar Singh@ Dharmendra Kumar and Chandan Kumar. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. He also submits that the petitioner is in custody since 29.01.2026. On these facts, he has prayed that the petitioner be granted regular bail. The learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer for the bail. Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered u/s 392 I.P.C. against unknown accused persons and the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner sprung up in the confessional statement of co-accused Dharendra Kumar Singh@ Dharmendra Kumar and Chandan Kumar who have already been acquitted. Further, the petitioner has submitted that he is not having any criminal antecedent and nothing contrary to that has come in the case diary. Also, the charge sheet has already been submitted in this case and nowhere it has come in the entire case diary that the petitioner ever tried to tamper with the evidence. Moreover, he is in judicial custody since 29.01.2026. Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner Putu Yadav is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
