ORDER

04.04.2026

The present regular bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner Munna Paswan @ Munna Kumar @ Ashok Kumar, who is in judicial custody since 02.03.2026, in connection with Deepnagar P.S. Case No.112/2026, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 324(4), 352, 303(2), 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S.

The prosecution case, in brief, as per written information of the informant Sona Paswan is that on 28.02.2026 at about 09:30 A.M., while he along with Diwakar Yadav was proceeding on motorcycle carrying cash of Rs.1,50,000/- for payment of advance for tent arrangement, near ethanol factory at Mahanandpur, several named accused persons along with unknown persons allegedly armed with sword, iron rod, sticks and country-made pistol surrounded them and assaulted the informant. It is alleged that one accused assaulted him with iron rod causing injury and others assaulted with sticks, damaged motorcycle and one accused snatched Rs.1,50,000/- from his pocket. The informant was taken to Sadar Hospital where he was treated. On the basis of the said written information, the present case has been registered against several accused persons including the petitioner.

Heard the learned counsel Sri Viren Kumar for the petitioner as well as learned A.P.P. Smt. Kumari Nirmala Sinha on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated due to previous enmity. It is further submitted that no bail application on behalf of the petitioner either anticipatory or regular was earlier filed

either or before this learned court or the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. That the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in judicial custody since 02.03.2026. The petitioner is F.I.R. named accused but no specific overt act has been attributed against him. It is argued that the allegation is omnibus and general in nature against all accused persons. It is further submitted that as per injury report, the informant sustained only three injuries, out of which two are simple and one fracture on left hand, which is not on vital part of the body. It is further submitted that although 12 named accused and several unknown persons are alleged, only three injuries were found which falsifies the exaggerated allegation. It is also submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, is a Government servant posted as Amin and there is no likelihood of absconding. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 02.03.2026 and undertakes to cooperate with the investigation.

Learned APP opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and the allegations disclose assault and snatching of money.

Heard both sides and perused the case record. From perusal of the case record, it appears that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R., however the allegations against all accused persons are general and omnibus in nature. No specific overt act has been attributed to the present petitioner. It further appears that the occurrence is alleged to have been committed by large number of persons but the injury report shows only three injuries, out of which two are simple in nature and one fracture over left hand. The injury is not on vital part of the body. It also appears that though allegation of intention to kill has been made, the nature of injury and surrounding circumstances do not prima facie support such intention. The medical report does not indicate any life-threatening injury. The case appears to have arisen out of previous occurrence and there is possibility of exaggeration. It further appears that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 02.03.2026. There is nothing on record to show that the petitioner has any criminal antecedent. The petitioner is stated to be a Government servant and permanent resident, therefore chances of absconding appear remote. Investigation can proceed even if the petitioner is released on bail. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in further custody. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of allegation, general and omnibus role assigned to the petitioner, nature of injury, period of custody and absence of criminal antecedent, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner is allowed. Hence, let the petitioner be released on

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bail on furnishing bail bond of **two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- like amount each** to the satisfaction of the learned court below

- (i) The petitioner shall not misuse the bail and shall appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing scrupulously.
- (ii) The petitioner shall not indulge in to similar offence or any other offence in the event of release on bail.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not temper/influence any evidence/witness in any manner.
- (iv) The petitioner shall intimate the Court in advance in case of any change of his residential address.
