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	20-04-2026	The anticipatory bail petition dated 24.03.2026 received to this Court on 26.03.2026 filed on behalf of petitioner Akhlesh Paswan @ Akhilesh Paswan, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 138/2020 instituted for the offences punishable under Sections 498(A), 323, 504, 506 IPC and 3/4 D.P. Act, has been placed before me for order after hearing, a copy of it has already been supplied to the learned A.P.P. Heard the learned counsel Sri Kundan for the petitioner as well as the learned Addl.P.P. Sri Amir Singh on behalf of the State. The prosecution story as per the typed report of informant Puja Devi, in brief, is that her marriage was solemnized with Kanhaiya Paswan on 13.02.2019. In her marriage her father gave Rs. 3 lakhs cash, a glamour motorcycle and a gold chain as gift and also at the time of Duragaman her father gifted furniture etc. She lived properly in her matrimonial home for two months and after that her husband Kanhaiya Paswan, father-in-law Akhilesh Paswan, brother in law Vishal Paswan, mother-in-law Girija Devi demanded Rs. 1 lakh to which her father could not gift. Thereafter, the informant husband started torturing and abusing her. He assaulted her many a times. On 10.09.2020 her husband father-in-law and mother-in-law assaulted her and made her fled away. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. Also, he submitted the petitioner is the father in law and he is residing separately since long and has no concern with the informant. Further, he is not having any criminal antecedent. On these facts, he prayed that the petitioner be granted anticipatory bail. The learned Addl.P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail. Having gone through the case record, it transpires that this

It appears that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. Also, he is the father-in-law. Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner Akhlesh Kumar @ Akhilesh Kumar is directed to be admitted on anticipatory bail on furnishing his bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court within one month from the communication of this order subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482 B.N.S.S..
