<u>26.05.2026</u>	This regular Bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely (1) Shatrudhan Sah @ Biltu Sah, S/o Late Ramvaran Sah, R/o Village – Kaadi Bigha, P.S.- Bhagan Bigha, Dist – Nalanda, who is in custody since 23.02.2026 in connection with Sare P.S. Case No. 05/2026, registered u/s 87, 137(2) of BNS. Shri Dhrub Kr. Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, submitted that no bail application has previously been filed either before this learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. and no specific allegation disclosing commission of any offence has been attributed against him. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no concern whatsoever with the affairs of the informant or the alleged love relationship. Learned counsel further submitted that after a lapse of about one month, the victim was allegedly subjected to pressure and tutoring by her parents and, in connivance with the enemies of the petitioner, a false and concocted story was fabricated and subsequently placed before the learned Magistrate, on the basis of which the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It was further submitted that the petitioner has criminal antecedents and two cases are stated to be pending against him, as mentioned in paragraph no. 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 23.02.2026. Accordingly, learned counsel prayed for enlarging the petitioner on bail. Learned P.P. on the other hand has opposed the prayer for bail of petitioner.

<u>Contd.</u> <u>26.05.2026</u>	Having heard both sides and upon perusal of the case records, it appears that the present case was instituted on the basis of a written complaint submitted by the informant, Subhash Prasad, wherein he has alleged that on 05.01.2026 at about 10:00 A.M., his daughter, Priya Bharti, aged about 26 years, had left her house for Sare Government High School to obtain her B.Ed. examination-related documents/certificates. However, she neither reached the school nor returned home thereafter. It has further been alleged that despite making extensive searches and inquiries, her whereabouts could not be traced. The informant stated that he received a phone call from a particular mobile number wherein it was informed that she would arrive late, however, thereafter the said mobile phone bearing no. 8582026599 was found switched off. Consequently, the informant approached the police station and submitted the written application regarding the missing of his daughter. A perusal of the Trial Court Record and the Case Diary, reveals that this case was filed against unknown for kidnapping of the informant's daughter. However, after recovery of the victim girl, the name of the present petitioner surfaced along with more serious allegations in her statement recorded under Section 183 of the BNSS, wherein allegations of blackmail, criminal intimidation, sexual exploitation and rape have been levelled against this petitioner. It further appears that charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioner under Sections 137(2), 87 and 64(2) of the B.N.S. and Sections 67 and 67(A) of the I.T. Act. Considering the gravity and seriousness of the allegations levelled against the petitioner and the nature of the offences alleged, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.
