	26-05-2026	The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Rohit Kumar, who is in custody since 02.05.2026 in connection with Laheri P.S. Case No. 366/2025 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 352, 3(5) of the B.N.S., is pressed today. The prosecution story as per the written report of the informant Vivek Kumar, in brief, is that on 25.07.2025 at about 12 O' Clock the informant reached near Soghra College on the motorcycle of his friend Gautam Kumar for purchasing a second-hand motorcycle from Surya Singh. It has been alleged that the accused Surya Singh assaulted him and took the motorcycle of the informant's friend, mobile and Rs. 3,640/-. When he went to complain about it before the father of the accused, namely, Upendra Prasad, then, the accused Upendra Prasad started abusing and assaulting him and made him fled away by pushing him. Heard the learned counsel Sri Vikash Kumar Mahto for the petitioner as well as the learned P.P. Sri Anuj Kumar on behalf of the State. It has been submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not named accused in F.I.R. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession except the confessional statement of the other co-accused. The alleged motorcycle has been recovered from the possession of the other co-accused Md. Juhaib Malik. The co-accused person has already been granted bail by this Court. The petitioner is a young boy aged about 20 years with clean past antecedent and he is in custody since 02.05.2026. On these facts, he has prayed that the petitioner be granted regular bail. The learned P.P. opposed the prayer for bail. Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 352, 3(5) of the B.N.S. against the accused Surya Singh Upendra Prasad and the name of the petitioner sprung up from the confessional statement of co-accused Md. Juhaib Alam from whose possession the alleged motorcycle has been recovered and he has already been granted bail by this Court. It appears that nothing incriminating thing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Also, it has been mentioned in the bail peition of the petitioner that he is not having any criminal antecedent and nothing contrary to that has come in the case diary received for hearing of this bail petition. Moreover, the petitioner is in judicial custody since 02.05.2026. Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner Rohit Kumar is directed to be released on bail on furnishing his bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
