<u>09.06.2026</u>	This anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely (1) Golu Kumar @ Prabhat Kumar, S/o- Late Tunna Prasad @ Pramod Prasad, R/o Village/Moh – Jodhan Bigha, P.S.- Belchi, Dist – Patna, at Present R/o Moh- Rehat Kuan, P.S.- Laheri, Dist- Nalanda who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Deepnagar P.S. Case No. 201/2026, registered u/s 115(2), 126(2), 74, 329(3), 303(2), 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS. Shri Ajeet Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner, has prayed for grant of bail and submitted that no bail application has previously been filed on behalf of the petitioner either before this Learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court. He submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated due to a dispute relating to repayment of an accommodation loan of Rs. 40,000/- advanced by the petitioner's father about five years ago. It is contended that, following an altercation over the said loan a few days prior to the alleged occurrence, the informant falsely instituted the present case to exert pressure upon the petitioner and avoid repayment. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner never visited the informant's house on the alleged date of occurrence and that there is no specific allegation of assault or theft against him. It is also submitted that the petitioner has a clean antecedent, as disclosed in paragraph 3 of the bail petition. Accordingly, prayer has been made to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Learned P.P. on the other hand has opposed the prayer for bail of petitioner. Having heard both sides and upon perusal of the case records, it appears that the present case has been instituted on the basis of a written complaint lodged by Informant, Gauri Devi. The informant, Gauri Devi, alleges	

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Contd.. <u>09.06.2026</u>	that on 15.04.2026 at about 11:30 P.M., the accused persons, namely, Gulshan Kumar, Golu Kumar and one unknown associate, came to her house and induced her to open the door by calling out as if they were family members. After entering the house, they demanded food, which was served to them. Thereafter, they demanded Rs. 10,000/- from the informant. Upon her expressing inability to pay, the accused persons allegedly tied her hands and feet with her sari, increased the volume of the television, and brutally assaulted her. It is further alleged that they throttled her, causing bleeding from her mouth and rendering her unable to move properly. The informant further alleges that after consuming liquor and assaulting her, the accused persons forcibly took away her earrings and cash amounting to Rs. 40,000/- and fled from the place of occurrence. Due to the injuries sustained, she had to undergo treatment at Sadar Hospital, Bihar Sharif. It is also alleged that at the time of occurrence, her husband had gone to attend a family function and upon his return the next morning, he found her unconscious. The informant further states that the accused persons had previously extended threats to kill her, her husband Mithilesh Pandey, her daughter Vandana Kumari and her son-in-law Sanjeev Pandey. On perusal of the Case Diary, it appears that the allegations have been levelled against all the accused persons in a general and omnibus manner, and no specific overt act has been attributed to the petitioner. The injury report available in the Case Diary reveals only a single abrasion injury on the neck, which has been found to be simple in nature. The co-accused, Gulshan Kumar, has already been granted bail vide order dated 05.06.2026 in A.B.P. no. 975/2026. Taking note of the aforesaid facts and circumstances available on record, I find it judicious to extend the privilege of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, namely (1) Golu Kumar @ Prabhat Kumar.
