(1) This Anticipatory Bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioners, namely, 1. Sulochana Devi and 2. Hari Yadav, Both R/o:- Village- Wena, P.S.- Wena, District- Nalanda, in connection with Rahui (Wena) P.S. Case No. 635/2022 registered U/S- 341, 323, 307, 498(a), 504, 506, 34 I.P.C. <u>PROSECUTION CASE</u> (2) The prosecution case, in brief, is that the informant, Kanti Devi, was married to Kumod Yadav in the year 2005. After 5–6 years of marriage, the petitioners started subjecting her to cruelty and began demanding ₹5,00,000 from her. They used to taunt her for not conceiving a child. On 03.12.2022, at about 10:00 A.M., the petitioners, along with other accused persons, abused the informant, threatened to kill her, and asked her to leave the matrimonial home. When the informant protested, her husband, Kumod Yadav, allegedly attempted to strangle her. <u>SUBMISSION OF THE COUNSEL OF THE PARTIES</u> (3) The learned counsel for the petitioners has prayed for grant of the anticipatory bail and has submitted as under: ● That the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence. ● That no bail application, either regular or anticipatory, has been filed by them earlier before this Court or before the Hon'ble Patna

		High Court. ● That the petitioners do not have any criminal antecedent. ● That the Investigating Officer submitted a final form in favour of the petitioners; however, the learned CJM, Nalanda, took cognizance against them on 11.03.2026 for offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 498A, 504 and 506/34 of the IPC. ● That the dispute between the parties has already been compromised. ● That a petition for divorce by mutual consent is pending before the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Nalanda. ● That the husband, Kumod Yadav, and the Bhasur (elder brother-in-law), Binod Yadav, have already been granted anticipatory bail. (4) On the other hand, the learned APP has opposed the bail petition and submitted that the offences are serious in nature and, therefore, the petitioners do not deserve the privilege of anticipatory bail. <u>MATERIAL ON RECORD AND FINDINGS</u> (5) From a perusal of the record, it transpires that the informant and the witnesses have supported the prosecution case. However, it also appears that the dispute between the parties has been compromised. Cognizance has been taken in the present case for offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 498A, 504 and 506/34 of the IPC. However, there is no material on record, at this stage, to substantiate the allegations under Section 307 of the IPC against the present petitioners. (6) Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the anticipatory bail petition is allowed. Accordingly, in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from the date of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing a bail bond of ₹10,000 (Rupees
