1. The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of petitioner, Shivranjan Kumar, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Kalyanbigha P.S. Case No. 32/2026 registered under Sections 303(2) of the B.N.S., later on added Section 317(2) of the B.N.S.. Also heard learned P.P. for the State.

2. Prosecution case, in short, is that on 13.04.2026 at about 11:30 P.M., while the informant and others came to their barn(Khalihan), saw 25 bags of lentil(Masur) were missing. In the meantime, 10-12 miscreants came there. On hulla, they fled away firing bullet. The informant gave name of the petitioner and others as miscreants. It is further alleged that the petitioner and three co-accused fired bullet.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that earlier, no bail petition either regular or anticipatory on behalf of the petitioner has been filed either before the Court of Sessions or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. The petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner. The stolen goods have not been recovered from the possession of the petitioner nor anyone has seen him stealing. There is no evidence to support the prosecution case. The alleged offences are not applicable in this case. Based on above submissions, he has prayed that the petitioner be granted bail.

4. On the other hand, the Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

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5. Perused the case record. As per allegation, the petitioner and other co-accused persons committed theft of 25 bags of lentil from barn(Khalihan) of the informant. They fled away firing bullet. Witnesses in case diary have supported the prosecution version. On disclosure of co-accused persons, 06 bags of Masur were recovered from house of co-accused Bikku Kumar. The case is under investigation. Statement has been made in Para 03 of the bail petition that there is no criminal antecedent against the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts, circumstances of the case and nature of allegation, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Hence, prayer for grant of anticipatory bail of the petitioner is hereby **rejected**.
