1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner Anil Paswan who is in judicial custody since 06.05.2026 in connection with Laheri P.S. Case No. 198/2026 registered u/s 318(2), 303(2) of the B.N.S. 2023. Also heard learned P.P. for the State.

2. Prosecution case, in short, is that the informant Bibha Kumari submitted a written report on 05.05.2026 alleging therein that she was residing at Nalanda colony on rent. The petitioner being tutor of her son caused to be fetched her ornaments by her son and sold the same in a shop. She got knowledge about the incident on 30.04.2026.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that earlier, no bail petition either anticipatory or regular has been filed on behalf of petitioner either before this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. There is no criminal antecedent against the petitioner. The petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in the present case due to false information. The alleged Section 318(2) of the B.N.S. is bailable and Section 303(2) of the B.N.S. is not applicable and super addition. The date and time of occurrence has not been mentioned in the F.I.R. and only said that she saw the box on 30.04.2026, then know that ornaments are not in the box and the written petition has been given to P.S. on 05.05.2026 that is much delay in giving the written petition. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 06.05.2026. Hence, the petitioner be granted bail.

4. On the other hand, Learned P.P. assisted by the learned counsel for the informant opposed the prayer for bail. Learned counsel for the informant submitted that several ornaments of the informant have been stolen away by the petitioner.

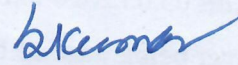

5. Perused the case record. As per allegation, the petitioner caused to be fetched ornaments of the informant by her son and sold the same in a shop. From Para 28 of the case diary, the petitioner is not accused in other case of Laheri P.S.. The petitioner is in custody since 06.05.2026. Statement has been made in Para 04 of the bail petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of this case, and detention period of the petitioner in custody, the petitioner Anil Paswan is hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of **Rs. 10,000/-** with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned.
