(1) This Anticipatory Bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner, namely, 1. Sonu Kumar, S/o.- Jagdish Gosain, R/o:- Mohalla-Amber, P.S.- Bihar Sharif, District- Nalanda, who is in custody in connection with Laheri P.S. Case No. 192/2026 registered U/S- 308(4), 308(5) B.N.S. <u>PROSECUTION CASE</u> (2) Prosecution case in brief is that on 22.04.2026 at around 8:54 P.M., the informant received a phone call from Mobile No. 7870986851, in which the caller said that he had got Sallu and Munabbar killed and also said that he had received a contract to kill the informant as well but he spared the informant on request of Raju L.G. The caller also said that he is constantly monitoring the moments of the informant. It is further alleged that on 29.04.2026, the informant again received the call from Mobile No. 7481866493 but the informant did not take the call. Later two maskmen came on Splendor Motorcycle and told the informant that why does not he pick up “Bhaiya’s call”. On 30.04.2026, the informant again received the call from the same mobile number but the informant give the phone to his friend Mumtaj. The informant has alleged that these calls were extortion calls and if he does not pay the money then he might be killed or his daughter might be kidnapped. <u>SUBMISSION OF THE COUNSEL OF THE PARTIES</u>

	(3) The learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed for grant of the anticipatory bail and has submitted as under: ● That the petitioners is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case due to local politics. ● The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. ● He has not filed any anticipatory bail petition or regular bail earlier before this Court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. ● That the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. ● That no specific has been attributed against the petitioner. ● That Section 308(4) & 308(5) B.N.S. are not attracted against this petitioner. (4) On the other hand, the learned A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the anticipatory bail petition and has submitted that the offence is serious in nature and, therefore, the petitioner does not deserve the benefit of anticipatory bail. <u>MATERIAL ON RECORD AND FINDINGS</u> (5) From the perusal of the record it transpires that the present case has been lodged u/s. 308(4) and 308(5) of B.N.S. However, there is no allegation in the entire F.I.R. that any money was demanded from the informant. No money was paid in connection with this case to anyone. From the perusal of the case diary, it is evident that none of the numbers from which the alleged calls were made belong to this petitioner. This petitioner has been implicated mainly only on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Vikash Kumar. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent. (6) Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the anticipatory bail petition is allowed. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the
