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	05-06-2026	The present petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner Aman Paswan, who is in judicial custody since 08.05.2026 in connection with Rahui P.S. Case No. 672/2025 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 329(4), 352, 3(5) of the B.N.S., is pressed today. The prosecution story as per the written report of the informant Gayatri Devi, in brief, is that her father-in-law Ashok Paswan has two brothers. The father of her father-in-law died six months back and Rs. 1,20,000/- were spent in her last rituals. Rs. 60,000/- were given by the sister of her father-in-law and both the brothers had to spend Rs.30,000/- each. The brother of her father-in-law, namely, Madan Paswan asked Ashok Paswan to give Rs. 30,000/- on his behalf also to which he will return within six months but even after six months he did not return the money. When the informant's mother-in-law demanded the money, after that on 05.12.2025 the accused Madan Paswan came to her house in intoxicated state and started abusing her mother-in-law Anita Devi. When the informant and her family members protested to it, the accused Madan Paswan went to his house and his son Aman Paswan, Aman Paswan's wife Gita Devi, middle and younger brother-in-law of Aman Paswan came to her house and started assaulting the informant's father-in-law, mother-in-law, sister-in-law, Chandani Kumari, brother-in-law Suraj Kumar with iron rod and stick. The accused Aman Paswan assaulted Anita Devi with iron rod at her head due to which she became unconscious and fell down. After that the accused Mandan Paswan assaulted the informant's mother-in-law at her right hand due to which her hand got fractured. After that Aman Paswan assaulted the informant's father-in-law with iron rod at his head due to which he sustained cut injury and blood started oozing out. The accused Aman Paswan and Madan Paswan assaulted Chandani Kumari with iron rod due to which her both the legs got fractured. After that the middle and younger brothers-in-law, Aman Paswan's wife and Gita Devi assaulted informant's brother-in-law Suraj Kumar with Lathi due to which his right hand got fractured. Heard the learned counsel Shri Nitish Kumar for the petitioner as well as the learned P.P. Shri Anuj Kumar on behalf of the State. It has been submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in the present case. The allegations against the petitioner are totally false, fabricated and concocted. The informant of the present case is own gotiya. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. He also submits that the petitioner is in custody since 08.05.2026. On these facts, he has prayed that the petitioner be granted regular bail. The learned P.P. opposed the prayer for the bail. Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 329(4), 352, 3(5) of the B.N.S. and the allegation against the petitioner is that he	

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	<u>Contd.</u> 05-06-2026	along with other accused persons came to the house of informant and assaulted informant’s father-in-law Ashok Paswan, mother-in-law Anita Devi, sister-in-law Chandani Kumar and brother-in-law Suraj Kumar. The injury reports of the all the injured as annexed with the case diary reflect that all the injuries are simple in nature except the injuries of Chandani Kumari which do not appear to be on the vital part of the body. As per para-105 of the case diary, the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedent. Moreover, he is in judicial custody since 08.05.2026. Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner Aman Kumar is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court subject to condition that the petitioner will cooperate with the investigation/trial.
