	03-06-2026	The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Amrendra Kumar @ Feku, who is in custody since 24.03.2026 in connection with Deepnagar P.S. Case No. 150/2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 109, 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S., is pressed today. The prosecution story as per the written report of the informant Puja Kumari, in brief, is that on 22.03.2026 at about 7:00 PM, the informant was at her shop of General Merchant and her father-in-law and mother-in-law were at the house. At that time the accused Kishore Chauhan, Amrendra Kumar @ Feku, Bharat Kumar, Nagendra Kumar, Anil Chauhan, Deepak Kumar, Alpana Kumari, Kanti Devi, Nitu Devi, Anita Devi, Abhishek Kumar and Abhinandan Kumar armed with Lathi, Axe, cleaver and iron rod came there and they started making the customers flee away and also they started damaging the articles of the shop. When the informant's mother-in-law Sushma Devi and father-in-law Ramjanm Prasad protested to it, the accused Kishore Chauhan and Anil Chauhan assaulted Ram Chandra Prasad with cleaver and the accused Amrendra Kumar attacked on him with iron rod due to which his left arm got fractured and he sustained two cut injuries at his head. The accused Nagendra Kumar assaulted Sushma Devi with iron rod, Deepak Kumar assaulted her with iron axe, Kanti Devi and Anita Devi assaulted her with iron weighing unit due to which her head got swelled and she suffered with severe pain in the whole body. On hearing the alarm, the informant's husband Prem Kumar and brother-in-law Shashikant Sagar came to house and they saw that their mother and father are lying on the floor and smeared with blood. They also saw that the accused Kishore Chauhan, Bharat Kumar, Nagendra Kumar, are assaulting Puja Kumari and Shashikant's wife with iron rod and axe and the accused Abhishek Kumar, Abhinandan Kumar are misbehaving with them. When Shashikant Sagar Protested to it, the accused Anil Chauhan, Amrendra Kumar, Kishore Chauhan, Alpana Kumari started assaulting him with iron rod and axe due to which he sustained injury at his left palm. The accused Abhishek, Abhinandan, Anita and Anil assaulted the informant's husband with iron rod and axe due to which he sustained injury at his head. It has been further alleged that the accused Anita Kumar, Abhinandan and Amrendra took the informant's gold ring, mangalsutra and silver chain. The accused persons took away Rs. 20,000/- and the food items from the shop. Heard the learned counsel Sri Navin Kumar for the petitioner as well as the learned P.P. Sri Anuj Kumar on behalf of the State. It has been submitted by the learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case by the informant on account of previous enmity and to save her family members from the Deepnagar P.S. Case No. 151/2026, dated 23.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 109, 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S.. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner as such the allegation are omnibus. The informant and the petitioner belongs to same family and they are own Chachera Gotiya. The petitioner was having one criminal antecedent vide Deepnagar P.S. Case No. 279/2004 which has been disposed by the J.J.B, Nalanda and he is in custody since 24.03.2026. On these facts, he has prayed that the petitioner be granted regular bail. The learned P.P. opposed the prayer for bail. Having gone through the case record, it appears that this case has been registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 109, 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S. and it also appears that there is no specific allegation against the	

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	Contd. 03-06-2026	petitioner. Also, it transpires that on 17.04.2026 the case diary along with injury report was called for. The case diary along with injury report was received but the final injury report was not received even after several directions. So, the Court has no option but to pass the order on the basis of material available on the record. The injury reports of all the injured persons available on the record reflect that all the injuries are simple in nature except injury no. 2 of Ramjanam Prasad which is mentioned as pain and deformity left wrist. This injury does not appear to be on the vital part of the body. Further, there is case and counter case between the parties. Moreover, the petitioner is in judicial custody since 24.03.2026. Thus, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner Amrendra Kumar @ Feku is directed to be released on bail on furnishing his bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court subject to conditions that :- (i) One of the bailor will be the close relative of the petitioner; (ii) The petitioner will cooperate with the investigation/ trial; (iii) The petitioner will remain physically present on each and every date till framing of charge.
