<u>08.07.2026</u>	This anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely (1) Navin Kumar S/o- Sanjay Paswan, (2) Ranjan Paswan, S/o-Jodhan Paswan, (3) Sujit Kumar, S/o-Benga @ Upendra Paswan, all are R/o Village – Hawanpura, P.S.- Rahui, Dist – Nalanda, who is apprehending their arrest in connection with Rahui P.S. Case No. 209/2026, registered u/s 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2) of BNS. Shri Md. Ali Imam and Sri Mahesh Paswan learned counsel for the petitioners, submitted that no bail application has previously been filed either before this Learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court. Learned counsel further submitted that the petitioner is innocent person and has not committed any offence whatsoever. It is submitted that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that the allegations made in the F.I.R. are general and omnibus in nature. It is further submitted that the petitioners have one criminal antecedent in Rahui PS Case No-161/26 and this case is filed by the informant and family members of the case and they are on bail, as stated in paragraph no. 3 of the bail petition. Further, they submitted that petitioners have filed a case against the informant SC/ST case No-107/26 (Rahui PS Case No-159/26), U/s-126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS and 3(1)(r)(6) SC/ST Act. Accordingly, learned counsel prayed for enlarging the petitioners on bail. Learned P.P. on the other hand has opposed the prayer for bail of petitioner. Having heard both sides and upon perusal of the case records, it appears that the present case has been instituted on the basis of a written complaint lodged by the informant, Sangeeta Devi. It is alleged that on 08.05.2026 at 1 PM her husband namely Amrendra Singh went to market and while returning	

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Continue <u>04.07.2026</u>	one neighbour's boy namely Prem Kumar came with her husband on his motorcycle and as soon as he reached near Chandriya turn, some of the accused persons namely Mantu Kumar, Dinesh Paswan, Rahul Kumar, Sujit Kumar, Naveen Kumar, Ranjan Paswan, Praduman Paswan and Rambali Paswan stopped my husband's motorcycle and started abusing him. When her husband refused to be abused, all the above mentioned people, with the intention of killing him, attacked her husband's head with sticks, While trying to protect his head, he was severely injured, breaking both his arms and legs. When Prem Kumar, who was sitting with her husband, tried to intervene, he was also assaulted by all the above mentioned people. During the assault, they took her husband's mobile phone, number 9517956990, and also took 7,000 rupees and a gold chain was snatched by Sujit Kumar and threatened to kill him if he filed a case. Thereafter, 112 vehicle arrived and brought her husband to the Primary Health Center in Rahui for treatment and further, he was sent to Sadar Hospital, Bihar Sharif, from where he was transferred to Pawapuri. Further, she stated that her husband went to Global Hospital, Bihar Sharif, where he is currently under treatment. Upon perusal of the record, it transpires that entire allegation of assault, as mentioned in FIR, is general and omnibus and no specific over act of assault has been attributed to any of the petitioners. The allegation of theft appears ornamental. The injury report does disclose grievous injury but the injuries are on non-vital parts of the body. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the prominent history of cross-ligation between both sides signifying an ongoing feud, the fact that the injuries sustained by the victim are on non vital parts of the body and the general and omnibus nature of allegations, I am inclined to allow the petitioners for anticipatory bail. Taking note of the aforesaid facts and circumstances available on	
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Continue <u>04.07.2026</u>	record, I find it judicious to extend the privilege of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners, namely (1) Navin Kumar, (2) Ranjan Paswan, and (3) Sujit Kumar, Accordingly, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, are directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the BNSS with additional following conditions:- • The petitioners shall present themselves before I.O. within 15 days of acceptance of their bail bond for questioning and shall offer complete cooperation in ongoing investigation. • The petitioners shall not indulge in provoking, threatening or tampering with any prosecution witnesses or family members of informant. • The petitioners shall not involve themselves in any similar offence in future.
