(1) This regular Bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioners, namely, 1. Vinay Kumar and 2. Pawan Kumar, Both Sons of Shiv Kumar Singh, Resident of Village- Hawanpura, P.S.- Rahui, District- Nalanda, who are in custody in connection with Rahui P.S. Case No. 177/2026 registered U/S- 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 74, 352, 3(5) B.N.S. <u>PROSECUTION CASE</u> (2) The prosecution case, in brief, is that on 14.04.2026, in the evening informant Priyanka Devi was sitting on her shop with her daughter Nandani Kumari, when Deepak Kumar entered the shop and caught hold of the hand of the informant and tried to pull, molest and abused her. When she protested then Deepak Kumar's brother Pawan Kumar and Vinay Kumar came to the shop armed with iron rod and Lathi and hit the informant's husband Mukesh Singh. Pawan Kumar beat her husband with iron rod due to which his head was ruptured. <u>SUBMISSION OF THE COUNSEL OF THE PARTIES</u> (3) The learned counsel for the petitioners has prayed for grant of bail and has submitted as under: ● That the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in the case. ● That earlier bail petition was filed before learned C.J.M., Nalanda which was rejected on 08.05.2026 and after that no bail petition has been filed before this Court or any Higher Court. ● That the petitioners do not have any criminal antecedent. ● That the petitioners are in judicial custody since 15.04.2026. ● That petitioner's brother Deepak Kumar is of unsound mind and who is undergoing treatment. Deepak Kumar had taken 4-5 packets of biscuits from the shop of the informant and was eating in front of shop, when informant's husband came and caught hold of Deepak	

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	Kumar. However Deepak Kumar managed to flee and in trying to catch him Mukesh Singh colided with the tractor and sustained injuries. ● The allegations in the written report are omnibus and not specific. (4) On the other hand, the learned APP has vehemently opposed the bail petition and has submitted that the offences are serious in nature and, therefore, the petitioners do not deserve the benefit of bail. <u>MATERIAL ON RECORD AND FINDINGS</u> (5) From the perusal of the record, it transpires that Mukesh Singh was treated in Primary Health Centre Rahui and sustained following injury:- Old stiched wound on Left side Parietal region of scalp size – 2” long. The injury was said to be simple in nature. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 15.04.2026. (6) Considering the simple nature of the injury and period of custody, the bail petition is allowed. Accordingly, the petitioners, namely 1. Vinay Kumar and 2. Pawan Kumar, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of ₹10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court concerned.
