<u>02.06.2026</u>	This anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely (1) Tanik Gop @ Tanik Yadav, S/o- Late Hari Gop @ Hari Yadav, R/o Village/Moh – Prahlad Nagar, P.S.- Noorsarai, Dist – Nalanda, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Noorsarai P.S. Case No. 463/2025, registered u/s 329(3), 329(4), 109, 308(3), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS and u/s 27 of Arms Act. Shri Nawal Prasad, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, has prayed for grant of bail and submitted that no bail application has previously been filed either before this Learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case due to village party politics. It is further submitted that no person sustained any injury in the alleged occurrence and there is no injury report available on record with respect to any of the alleged victims. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has not been named in the F.I.R. and that there is no direct or indirect evidence on record connecting the petitioner with the alleged offence. It is also submitted that the petitioner is suffering from a heart ailment and is presently undergoing medical treatment under the supervision of doctors. It is further submitted that the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled and both sides have entered into a compromise. In support thereof, a compromise petition has also been filed on record. Accordingly, Learned Counsel has prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Learned P.P. on the other hand has opposed the prayer for bail of petitioner but has admitted that a duly signed compromise petition has been filed by the informant before the Trial Court on 08.05.2026. Having heard both sides and upon perusal of the case records, it	

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Contd.. 02.06.2026	appears that the present case has been instituted on the basis of a written complaint lodged by Gita Devi. The informant, Gauri Devi alleges, that on 17.08.2025 at about 10:45 PM, unknown persons came to her house with the intention to kill her and fired several rounds. Earlier on the same day, the informant's husband, Ranjit Kumar, who was in Delhi, received a phone call from mobile number 8271435346, wherein an unknown caller introduced himself as "Banda alias Avadh Bihari" from Village Prahlad Nagar. The caller abused him and demanded ₹10,00,000 as extortion, threatening to kill him if the demand was not fulfilled. Later that night, at about 10:45 PM, Banda alias Avadh Bihari came along with Prithiwi Kumar and 4-5 unknown associates at the informant's house on motorcycles. They fired around 10-12 rounds and sped away on their motorcycles. On hearing the gunshots, villagers gathered at the place of occurrence and recovered four empty cartridges from the spot in their presence. The informant and her family are living in fear due to the incident. On perusal of the Case Diary, it transpires that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. His name has come up during the course of investigation on the basis of follow up statement of informant who claimed that the villagers had identified one of the accused as the present petitioner. Moreover, the allegation against him is general and omnibus in nature, and no specific overt act has been attributed to him. The named co-accused Prithiwi Kumar, has already granted regular bail vide order dated 27.05.2026 passed in B.P. No. 595 of 2026. Taking note of the aforesaid facts and circumstances available on record, I find it judicious to extend the privilege of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, namely (1) Tanik Gop @ Tanik Yadav. Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, is directed to be	
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
